Tawang is a picturesque town located in the northeastern state of Arunachal Pradesh, India. Nestled at an elevation of approximately 10,000 feet in the Himalayas, Tawang is renowned for its breathtaking landscapes, serene environment, and rich cultural heritage.

The town is most famous for the **Tawang Monastery**, one of the largest monasteries in India and a significant center of Mahayana Buddhism. Established in the 17th century, it is an architectural marvel and a spiritual haven for Buddhists.

Tawang is also known for its stunning natural beauty, with snow-capped mountains, lush valleys, and sparkling lakes like **Sela Lake** and **Madhuri Lake**. Adventure enthusiasts flock to the region for trekking, snow activities, and exploring remote passes like **Sela Pass** and **Bum La Pass**, which offers a glimpse of India's border with China.

Rich in Monpa tribal culture, the town celebrates vibrant festivals such as **Losar (Tibetan New Year)** with great enthusiasm. Tawang's warm hospitality, combined with its unique blend of spirituality and scenic charm, makes it a must-visit destination for travelers.



BRIEF ITINERARY







DAY 1: GUWAHATI TO DIRANG - PICKUP AND TRANSFER

- Early morning pickup and transfer to Dirang.
- Places to cover: Kameng River/ Tippi Orchid Garden/ Nag Mandir/ Dirang Monestry.
- Overnight stay dirang





DAY 2: DIRANG TO TAWANG - ENROUTE SIGHTSEEINGS

- 8:00 AM: Begin transfer to Tawang (Distance: 130 km, approx. 5 hrs 45 mins).
- Enroute Sightseeing:
- Dirang Hot Spring Water
- Sela Pass (13,500 ft): A stunning Himalayan pass with heavenly views of Sela Lake.
- Jaswantgarh Museum: A tribute to the heroic soldier, Jaswant Singh.
- Evening: Arrive in Tawang and check in at the hotel for an overnight stay.





DAY 3: TAWANG - DAY TRIP TO BUMLA PASS & MADHURI LAKE

- After Breakfast Begin local sightseeing
- Visit Bum La Pass (Indo-China border)
- Visit Sangestar Lake (Madhuri Lake) and Pangateng Tso Lake (P.Tso Lake).





DAY 4: TAWANG - FULL-DAY SIGHTSEEING

- After Breakfast: Begin local sightseeing
- visit Local Sightseeing (Gumpha, Monastery, war memorial, Lama Birth Place, Buddhist Statue) and back to the hotel
- In the evening visit Light and sound program and on the way visit the Local Market
- Night stay at Tawang Hotel.





DAY 5: TAWANG TO BOMDILA - TRANSFER AND SIGHTSEEING

- After Breakfast: Transfer to Bomdila (8,200 ft), the headquarters of West Kameng District, known for its Buddhist monasteries and cool climate.
- On Arrival: Check in to the hotel.
- Sightseeing
- Gontse Rabgyaling Monastery (Upper Gonpa)
- Thub-Chog Gatsel Ling Monastery (Lower Gonpa)
- Enjoy panoramic views of the Himalayan landscapes and snow-clad ranges.
- Evening: Visit the local market.
- Night: Overnight stay at Bomdila.





DAY 6: BOMDILA TO GUWAHATI - TRANSFER

- After Breakfast: Proceed to Guwahati.
- Exlore nearby attractions of guwahti on your own (If time permits)
- Night: Overnight stay at Guwahati.





DAY 7: GUWAHATI TO KAZIRANGA - TRANSFER

- After Breakfast: Check out and transfer to Kaziranga National Park, home of the "One-Horned Rhinoceros."
- On Arrival: Check in to the hotel.
- Evening: Free for leisure.
- Overnight: Stay at Kaziranga.





DAY 8: KAZIRANGA TO GUWAHATI - DROP

 After Breakfast Check-out from Hotel & Then proceed to Guwahati Railway Station / Airport. Here Your Tour End.
