ABOUT LADAKH

Offering scenic vistas of one of the a trip to Leh Ladakh India is all about the feel of snow-clad mountains, rugged landscape, soaring peaks, dangerous routes, and roaring bike engines. In short, going on a Ladakh bike tour is all about the good vibes and the undying spirit of a rider.

The largest town in Ladakh is Leh, followed by Kargil, each of which headquarters a district. The Leh district contains the Indus, Shyok and Nubra river valleys. The Kargil district contains the Suru, Dras and Zaskar river valleys. Its culture and history are closely related to that of Tibet. Ladakh was established as a union territory of India on 31 October 2019, following the passage of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act.

DAY 1 : DELHI TO MANALI

- We depart from Delhi around 6 PM in an AC Vehicle.





DAY 2 : A DAY IN MANALI

- Reach Manali by morning, have breakfast.
- We have kept this day for acclimatization purposes.
- However you can head out to visit some famous places in Manali like Vasishta Temple, Hadimba temple, The Mall road etc
- A short brief for the next day to start our trip further





DAY 3 : MANALI - SARCHU

- Wake up early in the morning, have breakfast and check-out the hotel.
- Later start your much awaited Ladakh trip on the famous Leh Manali highway.
- We'll cross the Atal Tunnel to enter Lahaul Valley.
- We'll also cross Darcha, Baralacha Pass for the enormous panoramic views.
- Reach Sarchu by evening.





DAY 4 : SARCHU - LEH

- Wake up, have breakfast and check out of the camps.
- It's a day of high passes. We'll need to cross one after the other to reach our destination.
- Initially, we'll cross the Gata Loops followed by Nakee-La and Lachung-La.
- Reach Pang by afternoon and have lunch in these gorgeous plains..
- Later on, we'll cross Tanglang La (second highest pass of the world) to reach Leh.
- Overnight stay in Leh.





DAY 5 : LEH EXPLORATION

- Post breakfast, head out to explore the region.
- Visit the Hall of Fame Museum, Shanti Stupa, Magnetic Hills, Pathar Sahib Gurudwara.
- Explore the local market and cafes. Do some shopping if you'd like.
- Strike a conversation with a local to know the culture and history of the place.
- Return to the hotel by evening.
- Overnight stay in Leh.





DAY 6 : KHARDUNG LA-HUNDAR-NUBRA VALLEY-DISKIT

- Wake up and have breakfast at the camps and then check out.
- Head for the beautiful Nubra Valley via Khardungla (Highest motorable road at 5359mt.)
- You will find yourself surrounded between the
- Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of Himalayas. Check in to the hotel and visit the Sand dunes (cold desert of India), take a camel safari (self paid).
- Come back to the hotel by evening.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Nubra Valley.





DAY 7 : NUBRA – PANGONG TSO LAKE VIA SHYOK VALLEY

- Wake up to see the first ray of sun falling on the mighty Himalayas.
- Post breakfast, head to Pangong via Agham and Shyok villages.
- Pangong Tso is a high altitude alpine lake and is the most fascinating lake because it changes its color according to the surroundings.
- Reach Pangong lake by evening and check-in to the campsite.
- Dinner and Overnight stay in Pangong.





DAY 8 : PANGONG TSO TO LEH VIA CHANGLA

- Post breakfast, head back to Leh.
- We'll cross the 2nd highest mororable road in the world "The mighty Chang La" situated at an altitude of 17,688ft.
- Reach Leh around evening.
- Dinner and overnight stay in this magical land.





DAY 9 : LEH – JISPA

- Post breakfast, head towards Jispa for the overnight stay.
- We will take the same route that we took to reach Leh from Manali.
- Reach Jispa by evening.
- Overnight stay in Jispa.





DAY 10 : JISPA – MANALI – DEPARTURE

- Wake up with the most scenic views in front. Have breakfast and check out.
- Head towards Manali. Reach Manali by noon. Explore the cafes and market area for some
- final shopping.
- Evening departure to delhi.
- Reach Delhi next morning.
