







ABOUT DESTINATION LADAKH

Renowned for its rugged peaks, desert landscapes, and serene monasteries, it spans 60,000 square miles (100,000 sq. km). Once part of Jammu and Kashmir, it became a Union Territory in 2019. The towering Himalayas separate Ladakh from Kashmir Valley, enhancing its isolation. Often called "Little Tibet," Ladakh shares deep cultural ties with Tibet, where Tibetan Buddhism and traditions thrive amid its breathtaking natural beauty.

ARRIVAL AT SRINAGAR | OVERNIGHT STAY AT SRINAGAR

- Upon arrival in Srinagar, our team lead will welcome you at the houseboat.
- Check-in and unwind, soaking in the serene surroundings.
- In the evening, meet your trip captains for a briefing session about the journey ahead.
- Explore the vibrant local markets or enjoy a Shikara boat ride on the tranquil Dal Lake.
- Overnight stay in a Srinagar houseboat.

SUGGESTED: TAKE AMPLE REST AND AVOID STRENUOUS ACTIVITIES, AS THE NEXT DAY INVOLVES TRAVELING THROUGH ONE OF THE COLDEST ROADS IN LADAKH.

SRINAGAR TO KARGIL VIA SONMARG, DRASS | OVERNIGHT STAY AT KARGIL

- Wake up early, have breakfast, and check out of the houseboat.
- Depart for Kargil, embarking on a scenic mountain journey.
- Pass through Sonmarg and cross the iconic Zoji La Pass (11,649 ft.), a gateway to Ladakh.
- Stop at the Kargil War Memorial, a tribute to the brave soldiers of the 1999 Kargil War.
- Drive through Drass, the second coldest inhabited place in the world, often called the Gateway to Ladakh.
- Continue towards Kargil, reaching by evening.
- Check in to the hotel and unwind.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Kargil.





KARGIL TO LEH | OVERNIGHT STAY AT LEH

- Wake up, have breakfast, and check out of the hotel.
- Depart for Leh, enjoying a scenic drive through breathtaking landscapes.
- Cross the high-altitude passes of Namika La and Fotu La, followed by the mesmerizing landscapes of Lamayuru.
- Drive through quaint villages like Lardo and Nimmo.
- Visit local attractions in Leh, including the confluence of the Zanskar & Indus Rivers (Sangam), Gurudwara Patthar Sahib, Magnetic Hill, and the Hall of Fame museum.

THINGS TO CARRY

1. Bag & covers

- Rucksack (minimum 60L) & a small backpack
- Backpack rain cover

- Sun cap & woollen cap
- UV-protected sunglasses
- 2+ pairs of inner thermals
- 1 fleece jacket & 1 warm jacket
- 1 pair of gloves
- 2+ long pants (trek/cargo pants recommended)
- 4 pairs of socks (2 cotton, 2 woollen)
- Trekking shoes with good grip & insulation (ankle-length preferred)
- Slippers/flip-flops
- Towel
- Rain jacket/poncho

3. Medications

- Glucose powder
- Tablets for headache, diarrhoea, motion sickness & altitude sickness
- Dettol, bandages, cotton
- Strepsils
- Sprain relief spray & crepe bandage
- Diamox (for altitude sickness)
- Any personal medications prescribed by your doctor



THINGS TO CARRY

4. Personal Accessories

- Toothpaste, toothbrush
- Paper soap, shampoo sachet
- Sunscreen (SPF 40+), lip balm, cold cream
- Body spray
- Reusable water bottle/flask (avoid plastic)
- LED torchlight
- Power bank & Bluetooth speakers (very important)
- And most importantly—your spirit for adventure!

5. Network

- Only postpaid SIMs work in Ladakh
- Recommended: Jio / Airtel / BSNL

6. Documents to Carry

- Govt. ID proof with photo
- Double-dose vaccination certificate
- Driving license (for bikers)

7. Cash

- Carry ₹5,000 in cash (ATMs available only in Manali/Leh)
- Bikers: Carry ₹10,000, as ₹5,000 is required as a security deposit per bike



NOTES

- INR 3500/- per person extra for double sharing basis.
- A 450cc bike is also available at an additional cost of ₹9,000
- INR 5,000/- needs to be submitted as security for the bike before the start of the trip. Any damage to the bike, except engine damage, has to be borne directly by the client.
- Biking option is available from 30 April onwards, since it's not safe to ride on the mountain passes during the April month because of Black-ice formation
- All the riders are required to wear a riding jacket at all the times they are riding the bike, else won't be permitted to ride the bike.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. May cause itinerary change. We reserve the rights to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general wellbeing.
- The age limit of our group departures is 16 to 45 years due to the power packed itineraries that we provide to our travellers. We can customise trips for travellers beyond the mentioned age bracket as a private trip.

CANCELLATION POLICY

NO REFUND SHALL BE MADE WITH RESPECT TO THE INITIAL BOOKING AMOUNT FOR ANY OF THE CANCELLATIONS. HOWEVER,

- If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. No Narcotics/Banned Substances: Strictly prohibited. We're not responsible for any consequences.
- 2. No Weapons, Fireworks, or Toxic Substances: Any violations of Indian law = not our responsibility.
- 3. Misbehavior = Eviction: Violating rules or misbehaving with fellow travelers will lead to eviction, with no refunds.
- 4. Outside Camp Safety: We are NOT responsible for your safety outside the campsite.
- 5. Damage to Property: Lost/damaged campsite items (tents, pillows, mattresses) = full MRP charge.
- 6. Valid ID: Must carry a govt-issued ID.
- 7. Guests: Only registered campers are allowed. Inform us if bringing guests.
- 8. Hot Water: Not guaranteed.
- 9. Booking Confirmation: Slots at the campsite are confirmed only after full payment.
