#### **ABOUT DESTINATION**




A trip to Manali will be inadequate if you miss visiting the enthralling Solang valley, which is one of the most widespread travel destinations of Himachal Pradesh. Solang valley is situated 14 kilometers to the northwest of Manali and welcomes thousands of tourists every year. Consider as a heaven for adventure devotees, Solang valley offers a plethora of activities like parachuting, paragliding, horse riding, Skiing, Quad biking, etc. there is a lot to explore and enjoy here in Solang valley on your Manali Trip.

Jispa, a beautiful little town in the Lahaul district of Himachal Pradesh, is a stunning must-visit. Perched on the banks of river Bhaga, Jispa lies 2 hours from Baralacha-la and provides the most stunning views of surrounding mountains!

While it is often regarded as a pit stop en route Leh on the Manali-Leh Highway, I beg to differ. This place is truly worthy of its own individually planned visit! Situated at a stunning height of 10,500 ft., this little village, home to about 78 households, serves as a halt for travelers on the long road trip to Leh-Ladakh. The calm, quiet and tranquil village with a very small population, offers the most beautiful Zen-like trip you will not soon forget.

#### **DAY 0: DEPART FROM DELHI BY 07:00 PM**

- Pit stop for dinner at any decent roadside restaurant.

Note: The pickup point will be Majnu Ka Tila (Near Vidhan Sabha Metro Station)




### DAY 1: REACH MANALI | JOGINI FALLS OVERNIGHT STAY AT MANALI

- Check in to the hotel, freshen up & have breakfast or lunch (Depending on the Arrival).
- After relaxing, head to Vashishth village, and begin the trek to the stunning Jogini Falls.
- Come back to the hotel, relax for a while.
- In the Evening, You are free to explore some local part of Manali – Mall Road. (At your own).
- Enjoy bonfire and DJ in the hotel.
- Overnight stay in hotel.




# DAY 2: CHECK OUT FROM MANALI | JISPA Via ATAL TUNNEL & SISSU | OVERNIGHT STAY AT JISPA CAMPS

- Wake up early morning, have breakfast and check out the hotel.
- Later kick starts your day with the road trip to Jispa via Atal tunnel
- We will head towards Baralacha La pass, it is one of the highest passes on the Manali Leh highway at an altitude of approx. 16090 feet.
- Later we will head towards jispa.
- Arrival at Jispa, Check in to the camps.
- Dinner will be served and overnight stay in Jispa Camps



# DAY 3: CHECK OUT FROM JISPA | PROCEED FOR KASOL | OVERNIGHT STAY AT KASOL

- Wake up in the Campsite.
- After Breakfast checkout the camps, Later board your vehicle and depart for Kasol. Rest for a while after short journey.
- Have dinner & overnight stay at Kasol Hotel.



## DAY 4: CHALAL VILLAGE | MANIKARAN GURUDWARA | DEPARTURE TO DELHI

- Wake up to see the first ray of sun falling on the mighty Himalayas.
- Post Breakfast, go for a hike to Chalal village and capture some beautiful views of Parvati Valley.
- Visit the holy Manikaran Gurudwara, famous for it's natural hotsprings. & Local Cafes
- In the night we will depart for Delhi.



#### **DAY 5: REACH BACK TO DELHI BY MORNING**

Reach Delhi in the morning.

- Accommodation for 1 night in a hotel at Manali, 1 night in Jispa Camps & 1 Night in Camp in kasol.
- 6 meals will be provided throughout the trip. 1 meal on Day 1 (Breakfast) + 2 meals on Day 2 (Breakfast + Dinner) + 2 meals on Day 3 (Breakfast + Dinner) + 2 meals on Day 4 (Breakfast)
