




ABOUT MANALI KASOL


Kasol is the Himalayan hotspot for backpackers and a base for nearby treks to Malana and Kheerganga.

Manali is a high altitude town situated at an altitude of 6398 ft at the northern end of the Kullu Valley alongside Beas River.

It's a hotspot for various adventureactivities like paragliding, river rafting, skiing, and many more. It also functions as a base for various treks and high passes such as Rohtang Pass, Baralancha pass, etc.

BRIEF ITINERARY





DAY 0: DEPART FROM DELHI BY 07:00 PM

Note: The pickup point will be Majnu Ka Tila (Near Vidhan Sabha Metro Station)




DAY 1: REACH MANALI | JOGINI FALLS | OVERNIGHT STAY AT MANALI

- Come back to the hotel, relax for a while.
- In the Evening, You are free to explore some local part of Manali – Mall Road. (At your own).
- Enjoy bonfire and DJ in the hotel.
- Overnight stay in hotel.



DAY 2: MANALI | SOLANG VALLEY | LAHAUL VALLEY Via ATAL TUNNEL SISSU | OVERNIGHT STAY AT MANALI

- Wake up with the beautiful sight in front of your eyes.
- Have delicious breakfast at hotel and then proceed for full day tour to Solang valley, Atal Tunnel & Sissu
- Cross the tunnel, ride towards sissu while admiring the Beauty of Lahaul Valley
- While returning, stop at Solang valley for lunch at your Own.
- You can indulge in various snow adventure activities offered at Solang valley like skiing, zorbing, atv rides etc. (At Your Own)
- Later come back to the hotel.
- Get your dinner served, overnight stay




DAY 3: MANALI SIGHTSEEING | PROCEED FOR KASOL | OVERNIGHT STAY AT KASOL

- Upon reaching Tosh, check in at your chosen Homestay.
- The rest of the day is at your leisure to explore the charming local offerings of Tosh.
- Spend a tranquil evening with friends gathered around a cozy bonfire, witnessing a stunning sunset against the backdrop of majestic mountains.
- Dinner will be served to complete your delightful day.



DAY 5: TREK DOWN TO BARSHENI | MANIKARAN GURUDWARA | TIME TO HEAD BACK

- Begin your day by waking up early to witness the first rays of the sun illuminating the majestic Himalayas.
- Trek downhill to Barsheni, making your way back to Kasol by afternoon.
- En route, make a stop at the renowned Manikaran Gurudwara, celebrated for its natural hot springs.
- In the evening, commence your journey back to Delhi by 4:00 PM



DAY 6: REACH BACK TO DELHI BY MORNING

Reach Delhi in the morning.
