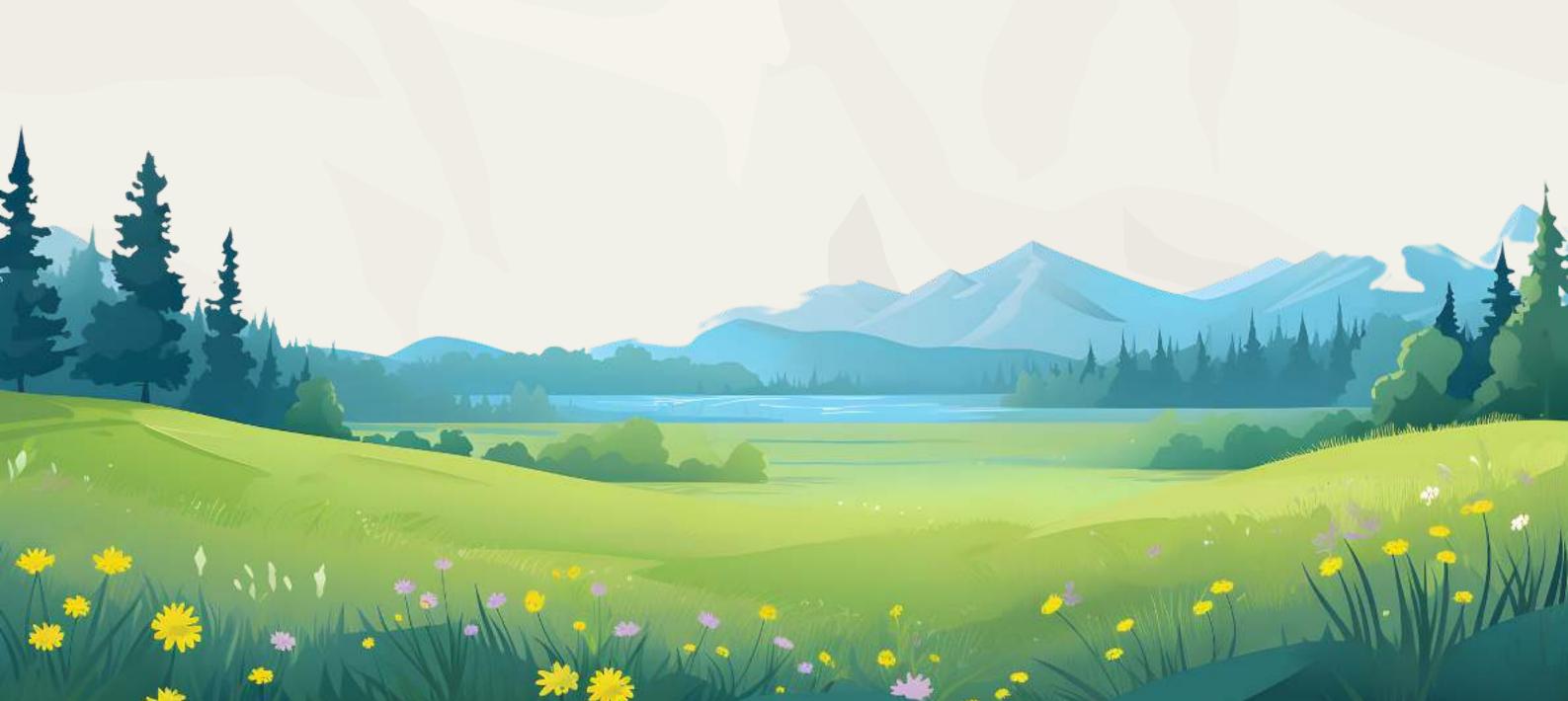

ABOUT DESTINATION HAMPTA PASS

Hampta Pass, nestled in the Pir Panjal range of Himachal Pradesh, is a stunning high-altitude mountain pass that connects the lush green valleys of Kullu with the stark, arid landscapes of Lahaul. Sitting at an elevation of around 4,270 meters, this dramatic crossover trek offers a striking contrast of terrains—verdant meadows, pine forests, and blooming wildflowers on one side, and barren, rugged mountains on the other. Best explored between June and September, the trail unfolds like a cinematic journey, crossing glacial streams, cascading waterfalls, and panoramic snow-laden peaks. Often referred to as a gateway for first-time high-altitude trekkers, Hampta Pass is also known for its ever-changing weather and surreal campsites like Chika and Balu ka Gera. Ideal for adventure nature seekers, the trek delivers and unforgettable experience that blends raw Himalayan beauty with thrilling exploration.

DELHI TO MANALI

• We depart from Delhi around 6 PM in an AC Vehicle.

NOTE: THE PICKUP POINT WILL BE ISBT (NEAR KASHMERE GATE METRO STATION)





MANALI SIGHTSEEING

- We will reach Manali by morning. Then you can check in to the hotel.
- Get your rooms allotted, get refreshed.
- Later enjoy local sightseeing visiting Hadimba Devi Temple and Tibetan Monastery.
- Visit mall road in the evening and come back to the hotel.
- Enjoy dinner with bonfire and music.
- Overnight stay in hotel.





DRIVE FROM MANALI TO JOBRA | TREK TO CHIKA

- Wake up in the morning, get refreshed and have breakfast in the hotel. Later we will check out the hotel and head towards Jobra, which is the starting point of the trek.
- The drive is scenic and 2 hours long. Then we reach the beginning point which is situated beside to the AllainGuhugal Hydel Project junction and start the trek. The initial trek is through the pine forest until we reach the Rani river valley. The forest route lasts for around one hour and we arrive on an open green land. We descend down and take the route going through the valley. The further route takes 2 hours to reach the Chika campsite. The entire trail is flat and mild uphill and it passes through the valley along the Rani river. We reach our campsite maximum by 4 PM and relax.
- Later, enjoy the sunset at the campsite.
- Dinner and overnight stay in dome tents.



TREK FROM CHIKA TO BALU KA GERA

- Post breakfast, we start our today's trek to Balu Ka Ghera.
- It takes about 5 hours to reach the campsite. We will have to cross a stream to reach the campsite.
- The trail is a mix of gradual ascents and descents and a flat walk after river crossing to reach the campsite.
- Overnight stay in camps.





TREK FROM BALU KA GERA TO SHEAGORU VIA HAMPTA PASS

- Post breakfast, start the trek for Shea Goru.
- The initial trail is an gradual ascent which will lead you to a slope of boulders and rough terrain.
- We will also reach the highest altitude today at Hampta Pass (14,100ft).
- The ascent to the pass is a hard mount but once you're at the top you can hardly feel the exhaustion.
- The second half of today's trek is the steep descent followed by a flat walk to reach Shea Goru. The descent is trickier than the ascent.
- From the bottom trek to Shea Goru is an easy flat walk and will take a couple of hours to reach.
- Overnight stay in camps.





SHEAGORU TO CHATTRU / DRIVE TO CHANDRATAL

- Today's trek is the easiest of all as we have to descend all the way to Chattru. We start by crossing the icy cold Sheagoru river and continue the trek on the right side of the river. After about one hour, we start seeing the road. It takes around 3 hours to reach Chattru. Relax and have lunch at the Chattru campsite. Then we start our drive towards the Chandratal lake if the weather remains good. The drive from Chattru to Chandratal is around 4-5 hours long. We take a stop at Batal, where you can click a photo at the famous Chacha Chachi ka Dhaba. The condition of the roads are too bad and gives the pure essence of the World's Treacherous road. Reach Chandratal and enjoy the beauty of this high altitude alpine lake.
- Chandratal, also called Moon Lake, is situated on the Samudra Tapu plateau in the Spiti valley. Nestled amidst the mountains, at an altitude of 4,290 meters above the sea level, the lake is known for its clear blue waters, magnificent views of CB-12 peak and pristine environment.





CHATRU TO MANALI | DEPARTURE TO DELHI

- Wake up and get ready for your journey back to Manali. On your way back we pass through the Atal Tunnel.
- The road journey is quite scenic.
- We reach Manali by evening, Later we will continue our journey towards Delhi.

NOTES

Before embarking on the Hampta Pass trek, it's crucial to be well-prepared and informed.

Here's an important message to consider before starting your trek:

- 1. Physical Fitness: Ensure that you are in good physical health and fitness. The Hampta Pass trek involves challenging terrain and high altitudes, so it's essential to be adequately prepared. Regular cardio and strength training exercises in the weeks leading up to the trek can help improve your stamina.
- 2. Acclimatization: Spend at least a day in Manali or a nearby location before starting the trek to acclimatize to the higher altitudes. This will help reduce the risk of altitude-related illnesses.
- 3. Pack Wisely: Pack only the essentials and keep your backpack as light as possible. Some crucial items to include are warm clothing, a waterproof jacket, comfortable trekking shoes, a good quality backpack, a first-aid kit, and personal identification.
- 4. Weather Awareness: Be prepared for unpredictable weather conditions. Check the weather forecast for the region before your trek and carry appropriate clothing and gear. Rain, snow, and sudden drops in temperature are common in the Himalayas.
- 5. Stay Hydrated: Proper hydration is essential at high altitudes. Carry a reusable water bottle and purifying tablets or a water filter. It's crucial to drink plenty of water to prevent altitude sickness.



- 6. Altitude Sickness: Be aware of the symptoms of altitude sickness, such as headache, nausea, and dizziness. If you experience any of these symptoms, inform your trek leader or guide immediately. Ascend slowly to higher altitudes, and if the symptoms worsen, descend to a lower altitude.
- 7. Trekking Permits: Ensure you have obtained all the necessary permits and permissions required for the trek. This includes checking with local authorities or tour operators about any permits needed for specific regions.
- 8. Leave No Trace: Follow the principles of Leave No Trace. Dispose of waste properly, avoid littering, and respect the environment and local culture. Leave the natural beauty of the Himalayas undisturbed for future generations to enjoy.
- 9. Trekking Group: If you're not an experienced trekker, consider joining a guided trekking group. Experienced guides can provide valuable knowledge, support, and safety.
- 10. Emergency Contacts: Carry a list of emergency contacts, including local authorities, your trekking group leader, and your family or friends back home. Make sure someone knows your itinerary and expected return date.
- 11. Respect Local Culture: Be respectful of the local customs and culture. Dress modestly, especially in villages, and seek permission before taking photographs of local people.



- 12. Insurance: Ensure you have travel insurance that covers trekking activities, including emergency medical evacuation if required.
- 13. Bag offloading is available at an additional cost of approximately ₹1500 (for a maximum weight of 10 kg).

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:
