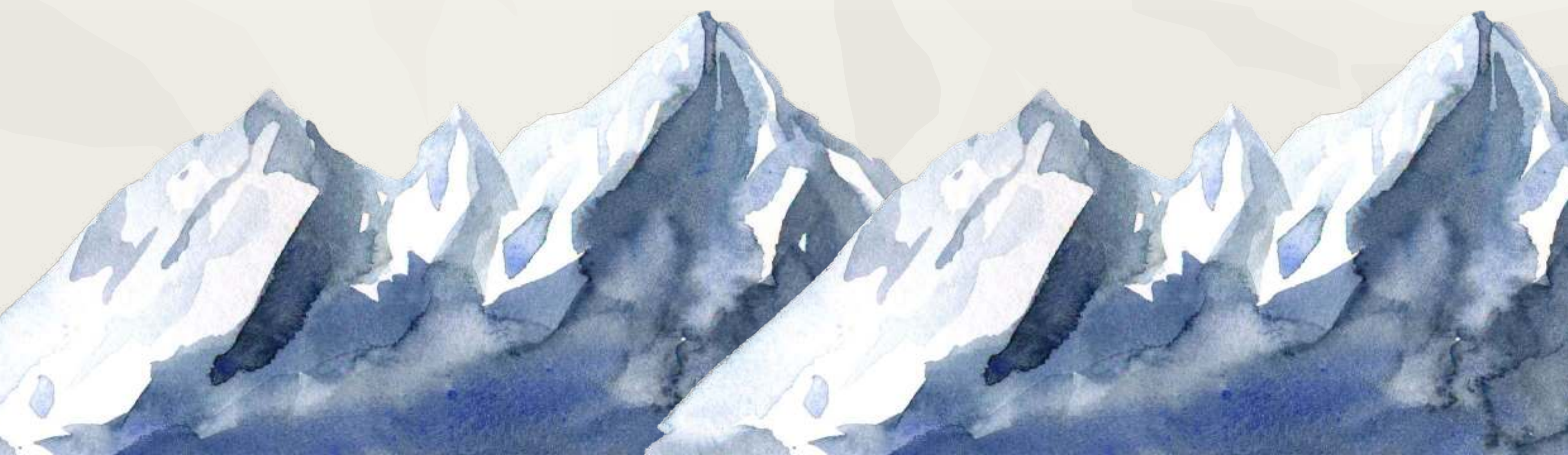
ABOUT DESTINATION

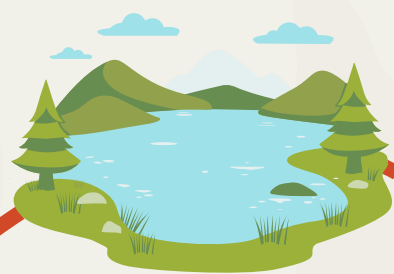
BRIEF MAP

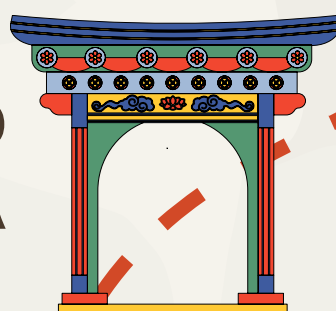

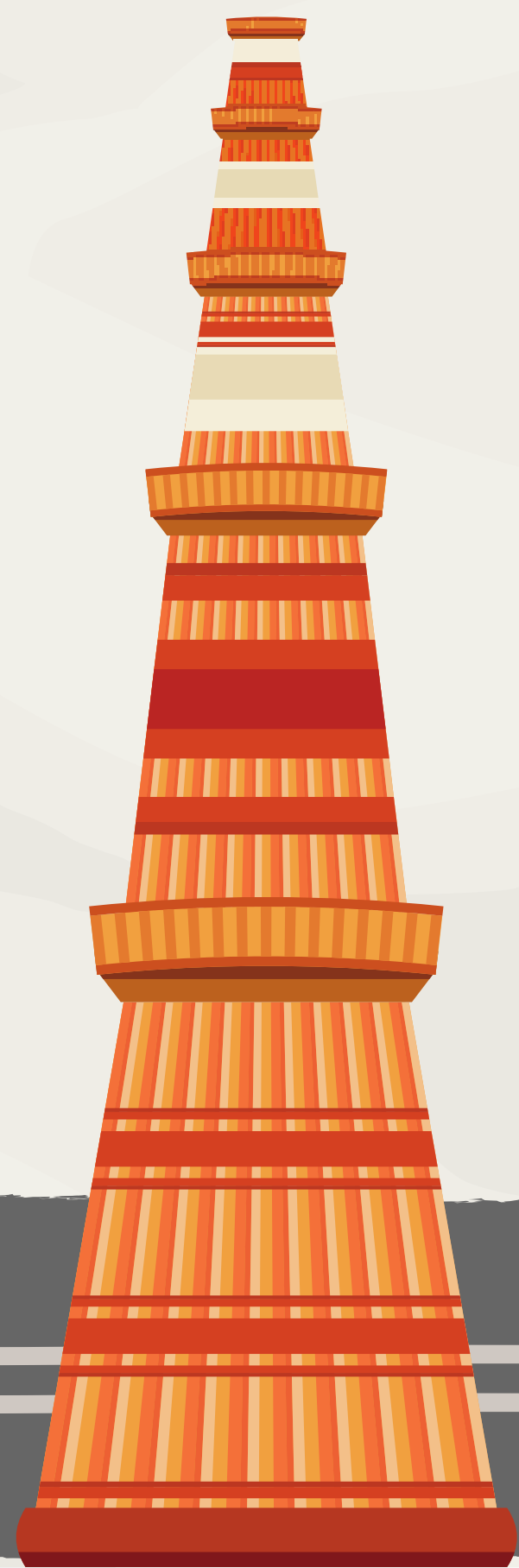
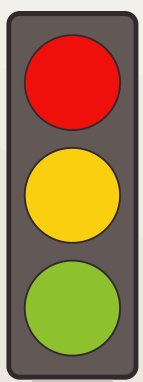

DAY 0

DEPARTURE FROM DELHI TO SHIMLA FROM DELHI BY 09:00 PM

- Assemble in Delhi around 9:30 PM.
- Travel overnight in an AC vehicle.
- Halt at a decent roadside restaurant for dinner.
- Continue the journey overnight to Shimla.





DAY 1

SHIMLA TO CHITKUL/SANGLA (VIA KUFRI & NARKANDA) | DINNER & STAY

- Breakfast in Shimla.
- Switch to 4x4 vehicles for a comfortable and safe off-road drive.
- Drive along the scenic Indo-Tibetan Highway via Kufri & Narkanda.
- Cross through the Kinnaur Gate, the rock tunnel gateway to Kinnaur Valley.
- Visit Chitkul, the last Indian village near the China border.
- Arrive in Chitkul/Sangla by evening.
- Dinner & overnight stay.

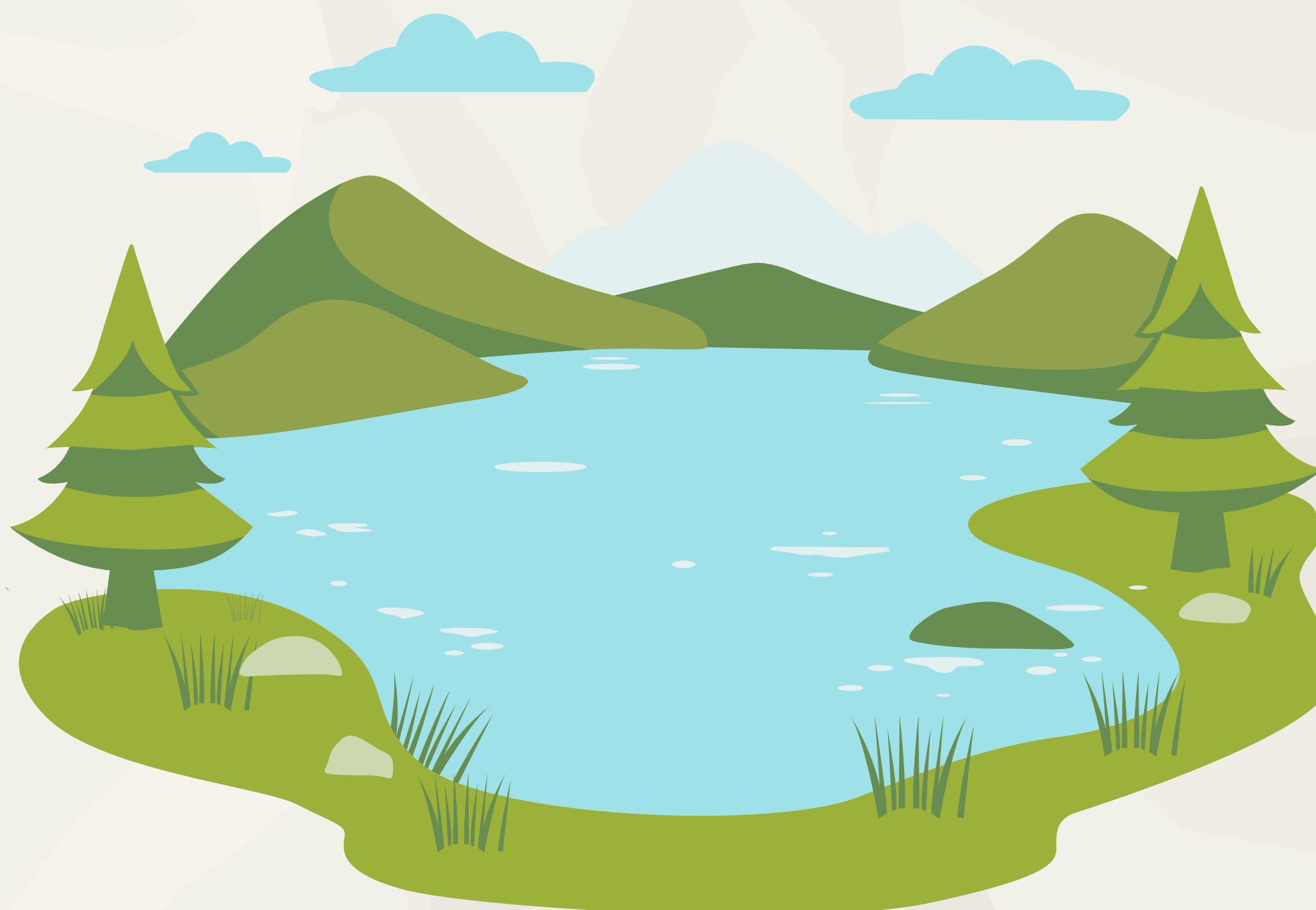




DAY 2

CHITKUL TO TABO (VIA NAKO) | DINNER & STAY

- Early morning breakfast and departure towards Spiti Valley.
- Drive through the famous Ka Loops.
- Visit Nako Lake and enjoy the scenic beauty.
- Reach Tabo by evening.
- Explore the historic Tabo Monastery (oldest in Spiti Valley).
- Dinner & overnight stay in Tabo.





DAY 3

TABO TO KAZA (VIA DHANKAR) | DINNER & STAY

- Breakfast at the stay.
- Drive to Dhankar Village.
- Visit Dhankar Monastery, overlooking the confluence of Spiti & Pin Rivers.
- Continue journey to Kaza.
- Check-in at the hotel/guesthouse.
- Dinner & overnight stay in Kaza.





DAY 4

EXCURSION TO HIKKIM, KOMIK, LANGZA & HULL/HANSA VILLAGE | DINNER & STAY IN KAZA

- Breakfast in Kaza.
- Day trip to high-altitude villages:
- Hikkim – World's highest post office (send postcards).
- Komik – World's highest motorable village (enjoy food at the highest café).
- Langza – Famous for the grand Buddha statue & Himalayan views.
- Hull/Hansa Village – A quaint village reflecting authentic mountain lifestyle.
- Return to Kaza in the evening.
- Dinner & overnight stay.





DAY 5

KEY MONASTERY, CHICHAM BRIDGE & KYOTO VILLAGE | STAY IN KAZA

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Key Monastery, the largest monastery in Spiti.
- Explore Chicham Bridge – the highest suspension bridge in Asia.
- Drive 7–10 km further to Kyoto Village, a peaceful Himalayan hamlet.
- Return to Kaza by evening.
- Dinner & overnight stay.

NOTE - KYOTO VILLAGE VISIT WILL DEPENDS ON WEATHER CONDITIONS

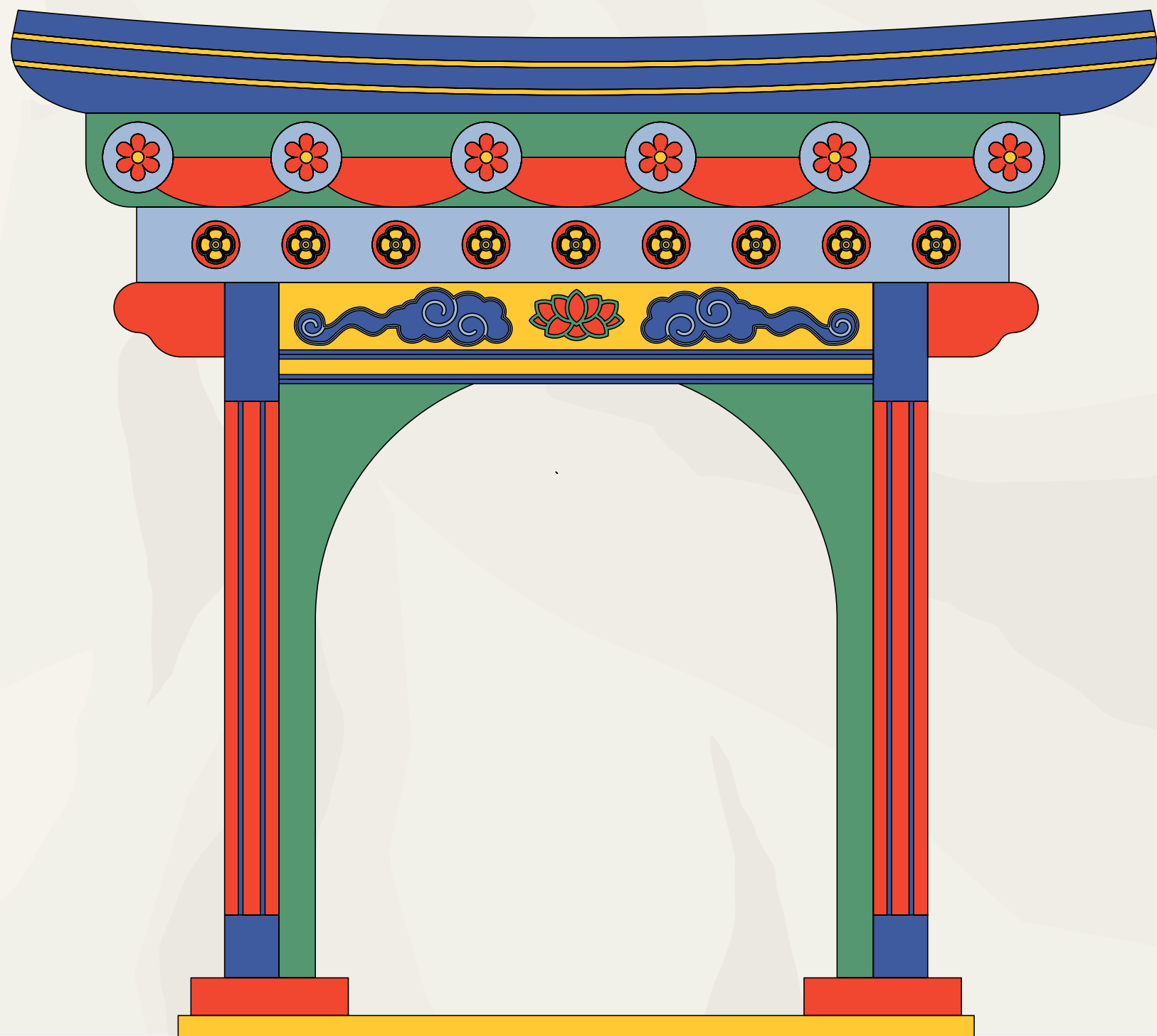




DAY 6

KAZA TO KALPA (VIA GUE MONASTERY) STAY IN KALPA

- Breakfast & check-out from Kaza stay.
- Drive towards Kalpa.
- En route visit Gue Monastery, home to the 500-year-old naturally preserved mummy of a Tibetan monk.
- Arrive in Kalpa by night.
- Dinner & overnight stay.





DAY 7

KALPA TO SHIMLA | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY TO DELHI

- Breakfast & check-out from Kalpa stay.
- Begin long drive towards Shimla (approx. 10–11 hrs).
- From Shimla, board the overnight Volvo bus to Delhi.
- Trip concludes with memories of Spiti & Kinnaur Valley.





DAY 8

REACH DELHI BY MORNING

- Reach delhi by morning.
- Back home with memories of the land far away but forever etched in us.





INCLUSIONS

- Volvo Transfers from Delhi to Shimla and Back
- Entire expedition from Shimla via 4X4 Vehicle.
- Accommodation for 6 nights – 1 Night at Chitkul, 1 Night at Tabo, 1 Night at Kalpa, 3 Nights at Kaza.
- Meals (12 Meals Including Breakfasts and Dinners)
- New Year Celebration
- Team Leader throughout the trip.
- Availability of oxygen 24x7 in case of any emergency.
- All applicable toll, parking and driver charges.
- All inner line permits.

EXCLUSION

- GST 5% applicable extra.
- Any kind of food and beverages that are not mentioned in the inclusions like Alcohol, Mineral Water, Meals, Refreshments and Lunches while travelling on highways.
- Any personal expenses like tip to drivers, entry tickets, photography/videography charges and any kind of activities on the trip.
- Any costing arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne by the customer on the spot).
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.
- Any damage to the bike except engine damage must be borne by the client.



NOTES

- Access to high-altitude regions of Spiti Valley, especially Hikkim, Komik, Langza Village, and Pin Valley, may be congested or inaccessible during winter months due to extreme snowfall. Hence, the stopover to these locations is weather-dependent. In such a case, we will look for the best possible alternatives, as achievable.
- Capture A Trip bears no responsibility for any such acts of God or the associated expenses.
- Travellers residing outside Delhi are recommended to book trains/flights reaching Delhi no later than 4 PM on the expedition start date. Similarly, on the expedition end date, book the returning flight/train departure post 2 PM respectively.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.
- Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or goods of travelers during the tour.



TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

- Customers are responsible for meeting all the health requirements, including necessary vaccinations. Any underlying medical conditions must be disclosed to Capture A Trip beforehand.
- Customers must follow all safety instructions during the trip. Failure to do so may result in removal from the tour without a refund.
- Participation in adventure activities is at the traveler's own risk. Customers must ensure they are medically fit. Capture A Trip is not liable for any injury, accident, or loss of life resulting from such activities.



TRIP EXECUTION:

- Capture A Trip reserves the right to modify the itinerary due to weather, road closures, political unrest, natural calamities, or safety issues.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delays or alterations in the program or indirectly incurred expenses in cases such as natural hazards, accidents, weather conditions, landslides, political closure or any untoward incident.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delay in reaching the destination due to traffic, sightseeing/activities of the day may get cancelled if we don't reach the destination on time.
- The trip organizer/coordinator has the complete right to change the itinerary as per the real-time conditions.

TRIP BOOKINGS:

- Registrations/Tickets once booked cannot be exchanged, cancelled, or refunded.
- In the event that the company is unable to operate a specific tour for any reason, alternative arrangements may be offered at the company's discretion. Once such alternatives have been provided, no further claims or objections shall be entertained.
- If the company makes alterations to your booked tour or holiday after your reservation has been confirmed, the following options will be made available to you:
 - You can go along with the altered tour or holiday plans.
 - Alternatively, you can opt for a different tour or holiday that the company suggests.
- In either of these cases, you won't be able to claim any compensation for damages, extra expenses, or any other losses.
