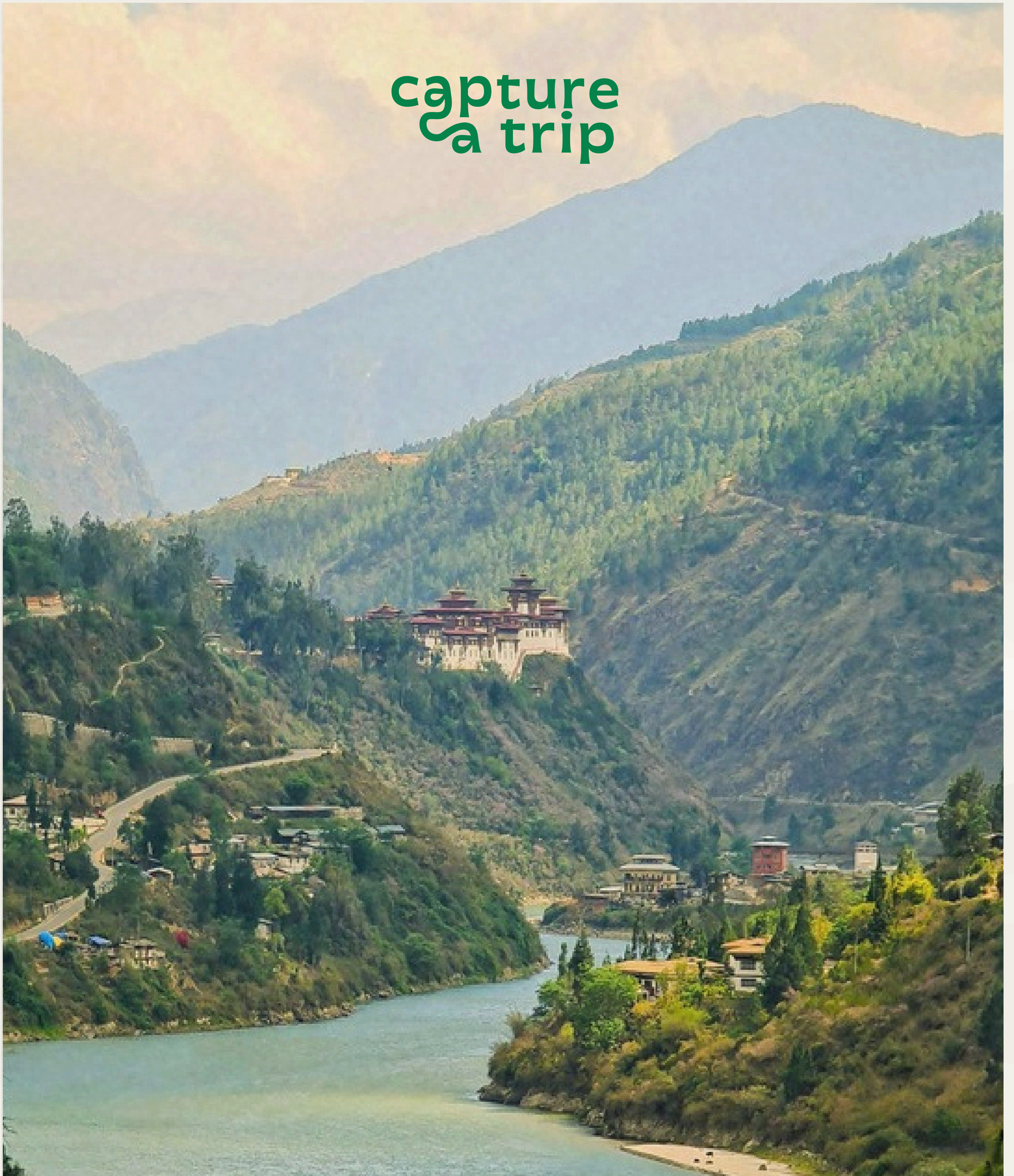

BRIEF MAP





DAY 1

ARRIVAL AT BAGDOGRA - BANGALDESH BORDER - STAY IN PHUENTSHOLING

- Upon arrival at Bagdogra Airport or NJP Railway Station, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to Jaigaon, the last border town of Bharat (West Bengal). En route, you will pass through the Indo-Bangladesh border area.
- After reaching the border, you will walk to the Bhutan Immigration Office to complete the entry formalities & welcome process. Once completed, proceed to Phuentsholing.
- Check in at the hotel for an overnight stay. If time permits, you can explore the evening market, Duty-Free shops, and Gold shops, and visit Zangto Pelri Monastery. You will also have free time to enjoy café visits and explore the local surroundings at your own pace.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Phuentsholing.

NOTE :

- The departure from the pick-up location is scheduled for approximately 2:30 PM, either from the airport or a nearby location for Railway station .
- On arrival at the border, guests will disembark from the Indian vehicle with their luggage and proceed for immigration formalities. After completing the process...



DAY 2

PHUENTSHOLING TO PARO-ENROUTE PARO NIGHT MARKET

- After breakfast, meet your trip captain/Guide at the hotel for a short briefing and assistance with permit formalities. Once the permits are obtained (approximately 30 minutes), you may explore Phuentsholing town before beginning your journey to Thimphu.
- En route, visit Kharbandi Monastery and the Eight Dharma Kaya Stupas. Enjoy scenic views along the way, including Gedu town, the Dam Viewpoint, and a beautiful waterfall near Chuzom.
- Upon arrival in Paro, if time permits, explore the local market, known for its affordable shopping options. Later, check in at the hotel and relax.
- Overnight stay in Paro, in the scenic valley area.

Bike Trip Guests will collect their assigned vehicles, and receive their bikes.



DAY 3

TAKTSANG MONASTERY (TIGER'S NEST)

- After breakfast Drive to Taktsang Monastery, famously known as Tiger's Nest, is Bhutan's most iconic and sacred site. Its most remarkable specialty lies in its extraordinary location—dramatically perched on a steep cliff around 900 meters above the Paro Valley, making it one of the most visually breathtaking monasteries in the world.
- After breakfast, set out on an unforgettable 5–8 hour trekking journey to this legendary site. As you ascend through pine forests, fluttering prayer flags, and panoramic mountain viewpoints, the experience builds anticipation for the awe-inspiring sight of the monastery itself.
- If time permits, you may also visit additional attractions in Paro, including the historic Paro Dzong and Rinpung Dzong, both renowned for their cultural and architectural significance.
- Optional activities: Hot stone bath or cultural shows .
- Return to Paro for an overnight stay.





DAY 4

TRANSFER TO PARO ENROUT THIMPHU FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING

- After breakfast and checkout, proceed for local sightseeing including the Paro Airport Viewpoint, Traditional Dress Point, and a visit to Paro Market.
- Visit the Paro Airport Viewpoint, known for its dramatic location and breathtaking scenery. Paro International Airport, the only international airport in Bhutan, is located about 6 km from Paro town in a deep valley along the Paro Chhu River. It is renowned for its challenging approach, with only a limited number of certified pilots worldwide qualified to land due to the surrounding 18,000-foot Himalayan mountains.
- Continue sightseeing based on time and road conditions, including visits to the fertility Temple , Vegetable Market, Buddha Dordenma, Simply Bhutan, and if time permits, Takin Zoo, the Post Office, Handicraft Market, and the Paper Factory.
- Please note: The itinerary may be adjusted depending on road conditions and time availability.
- Overnight stay.





DAY 5

THIMPHU TO PUNAKHA & DOCHULA PASS EXCURSION | THIMPHU NIGHT LIFE

- After breakfast, drive via the scenic Dochula Pass, known for its stunning Himalayan views. Visit Simtokha Dzong, the first Dzong built in 1631, rich in historical significance.
- Continue to Punakha, the former capital of Bhutan, where you will visit the majestic Punakha Dzong and enjoy optional river rafting.
- On the return journey, head back to Thimphu for an overnight stay.
- In the evening, those interested can explore Thimphu nightlife at places like Mojo Park and Space 34 Avenue 28, offering live music & karaoke Nights and a relaxed atmosphere. Bhutan's nightlife is calm and cultural, ideal for a peaceful end to the day.

DAY 6

THIMPHU TO SILIGURI / PHUENTSHOLING CHELE LA PASS – EN ROUTE SIGHTSEEING

- After breakfast, depart for Siliguri / Phuentsholing. En route, enjoy scenic Remaining sightseeing around Thimphu along with beautiful Himalayan landscapes and short breaks as per road conditions.
- Important Notes:
- For private guests and bike riders, the last night stay will be in Phuentsholing only (not Siliguri).
- For Tempo Guest guests, the last night stay will be in Siliguri.
- Visit to Chele La Pass (3,988 m / 13,083 ft – the highest motorable point in Bhutan) is applicable only for bike riders, subject to itinerary conditions.
- Stay in Siliguri / Phuentsholing





DAY 7

DEPARTURE

- After breakfast, check out from your hotel in Phuentsholing or Siliguri. You may book your flight at a time that suits your schedule.
- For group travelers, drop will be arranged to IXB Airport from Siliguri between 11:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Please ensure your flight is scheduled after 2:00 PM.

- Accommodation: 6 nights in 3-star premium hotels (double sharing basis)
- Stay 1 night Phuentsholing, 2 nights Thimphu, 2 nights Paro, 1 night Siliguri / Phuentsholing (as per trip type)

- Bhutan SDF (Sustainable Development Fee) – INR 1200 per person per day
- Bhutan visa/permit assistance & immigration support

Note Indian driving license is mandatory. Voter ID is accepted only if it is valid and has a hologram.



EXCLUSIONS

- GST (5%) is applicable extra
- Security deposit of INR 5,000 per Rider Refundable on the spot
- Travel insurance & medical expenses
- Air fare / Train fare / Bus fare.
- Entry tickets to any Monuments are not included.
- Any other meals not mentioned in the inclusions.
- Personal Expenses such as Laundry, telephone calls, tips & gratuity. Mineral / soft / hard drinks, Paragliding, River rafting, joy ride, Pony Ride, Cable Car.
- Room Heater, Local Cab fare & Entrance Fees.
- Bhutanese Cultural Program, Traditional Dance or Campfire.
- Additional sightseeing or extra usage of vehicle, other than mentioned in the itinerary.
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like, landslides, road blockage, political disturbances, etc. (to be borne by the client, who is directly payable on the spot).
- Any increase in taxes or fuel price, leading to increase in cost on surface transportation & land arrangements, which may come into effect prior to departure.

BIKE NOTES

- Rider is responsible for the bike after handover. A refundable security deposit of INR 5,000 is required at the time of bike allocation, which will be refunded after successful handover, subject to inspection.
- Any damages to the bike will be borne by the rider. A valid driving license is mandatory. No cancellations are allowed once the bike booking is confirmed. The rental period is 5 days. Riders must strictly follow the instructions of the Road Captain at all times. Signing of the disclaimer is mandatory before the ride begins.



DO'S

RESPECT LOCAL CUSTOMS & MONASTERIES

- Always walk clockwise around stupas & prayer wheels.
- Remove shoes & hats before entering monasteries and dzongs.
- Maintain silence inside religious sites.

FOLLOW BHUTAN'S DRESS CODE IN DZONGS & MONASTERIES

- Wear full-sleeved shirts, long pants, and closed shoes.
- Avoid shorts, sleeveless tops, and hats inside religious places.

CARRY BHUTANESE NGULTRUM (BTN) OR INDIAN RS (₹)

- Indian ₹notes are accepted; carry ₹100 denominations.

PACK FOR CHANGING WEATHER

- Layered clothing is best since temperatures vary across locations.
- Comfortable trekking shoes for Tiger's Nest hike.

TRY LOCAL BHUTANESE CUISINE

- Must-try: Ema Datshi (spicy cheese & chili dish), Suja (butter tea), Red Rice.

KEEP YOUR ENTRY PERMIT & PASSPORT HANDY

- You will need your permit for check-posts when traveling between cities.



DONT'S

NO PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (PDA)

- Holding hands is okay, but kissing or hugging in public is considered disrespectful.

DO NOT POINT AT RELIGIOUS OBJECTS OR PEOPLE

- Use an open palm instead of pointing fingers.

AVOID DISRESPECTING THE ROYAL FAMILY

- Criticizing Bhutan's King or Government is strictly discouraged.

DON'T SMOKE IN PUBLIC PLACES

- Bhutan has strict anti-smoking laws. Carry import permits if bringing cigarettes.

DO NOT LITTER

- Bhutan takes cleanliness seriously. Use designated bins.

AVOID BUYING ANTIQUE RELIGIOUS ARTIFACTS

- Taking antique religious items out of Bhutan is illegal.

NO OUTSIDE DRONES ALLOWED

- Flying drones requires special permits from the Bhutanese government.



NOTES

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR BHUTAN:

- Bring your original Voter Card or a valid Indian passport. (Passport with six months of validity from the last day of your Bhutan trip)
- For Children (Under 18): - Passport or Birth Certificate.
- Notice: Aadhaar Card is not accepted for adults or children.
- If using a Voter ID, it must be the original issued by a government
- Please carry your 04 (four) copies of Passport size photo and ID proof (Voter ID card / Passport) for permission to visit Bhutan. In this connection please note that Aadhaar Card for identity purpose is not accepted in Bhutan.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.
