DAY 1

ARRIVAL AT BAGDOGRA AIRPORT TO PHUENTSHOLING

- Duration: 3 hrs 45 mins (152.9 km)
- On arrival at Bagdogra Airport, our representative will welcome you and transfer you to Jaigaon, the last border town of Bharat, West Bengal.
- After crossing the border, you will walk to the Bhutan Immigration office for entry formalities.
- Check in at the pre-booked hotel for an overnight stay in Phuentsholing.
- If time permits, you can explore the evening market and visit Zangtopelri.
- Dinner and overnight stay in phuentsholing.

NOTE : THE DEPARTURE FROM THE PICK-UP LOCATION IS SCHEDULED FOR APPROXIMATELY 1:00 PM, EITHER FROM THE AIRPORT OR A NEARBY LOCATION





DAY 2

PHUENTSHOLING TO THIMPHU – TRAVEL TO THE CAPITAL CITY OF BHUTAN

- Duration: 3 hrs 46 mins (145.6 km)
- After breakfast, meet with your Bhutanese guide at the hotel for a briefing and assistance with visa/permit formalities.
- After obtaining your permit (approx. 30 mins), explore Phuentsholing city, then proceed towards Thimphu.
- En route, visit Kharbandi Monastery and enjoy scenic views of Gedu, Melaraypa Lhakhang town, Dam Viewpoint, and the waterfall near Chuzom.
- Arrive in Thimphu, check into the hotel, and relax.
- overnight stay at thimphu.

FOR THOSE SEEKING TO EXPERIENCE THE NIGHTLIFE IN BHUTAN, THIMPHU IS THE IDEAL DESTINATION. A FEW NOTABLE VENUES TO VISIT INCLUDE MOJO PARK AND SPACE 34, WHERE GUESTS CAN UNWIND WITH LIVE MUSIC, DANCE, AND INTERACT WITH BOTH LOCALS AND FELLOW TRAVELERS.



DAY 3

THIMPHU FULL-DAY SIGHTSEEING

- Memorial Chorten – A beautiful stupa built in memory of the third king of Bhutan.
- Buddha Point (Buddha Dordenma) – Visit the giant statue of Lord Buddha with stunning valley views.
- Mini Zoo – See the rare Takin, Bhutan's national animal.
- Sangaygang View Point – Enjoy panoramic views of Thimphu and visit the BBS tower area.
- Handicraft Emporium – Shop for traditional Bhutanese clothes, jewelry, and crafts.
- Paper Factory – Learn about handmade Bhutanese paper, made using ancient methods.
- Wang Chu River & Clock Tower Square – Relax and explore the heart of the city.
- Thimphu Vegetable Market – Visit the local market for fresh produce and local flavor.
- Simply Bhutan Museum – A fun, interactive museum showing Bhutanese village life. Try archery, dress in local attire, and enjoy local rice wine (Arra).
- National Library – Home to rare manuscripts, ancient texts, and Bhutanese religious books.
- Tashichho Dzong (Evening Visit) – Explore the impressive fortress and seat of Bhutan's government





DAY 4

THIMPHU TO PUNAKHA -DOCHULA PASS | PUNAKHA DZONG | STAY IN PUNAKHA

- After breakfast, drive to Punakha, the former capital of Bhutan.
- On the way, visit Simtokha Dzong – the first Dzong built by Zhabdrung Ngawang Namgyal in 1631. It stands at the crossroads of three major regions: Sha, Wang, and Pa.
- Stop at Dochula Pass (3,050m) – Enjoy stunning panoramic views of the Himalayas and 108 memorial chortens.
- Arrive in Punakha and check into your hotel.
- After lunch, visit:
- Punakha Dzong – A magnificent 17th-century fortress located between two rivers.
- Khamsum Yulley Namgyal Chorten – A beautiful hilltop stupa with great views and peaceful surroundings.
- Optional activity: You can try Punakha River Rafting (direct payment required).
- Evening free to relax.
- Overnight stay in Punakha.





DAY 5

PHOBJIKHA VALLEY | GANGTEY VILLAGE

- After breakfast: Drive from Punakha to Phobjikha Valley
- Scenic glacial valley at 3,000m altitude
- Famous for Siberian Black-Necked Cranes*
- One of Bhutan's most beautiful and unspoiled valleys, known for its rolling green meadows, alpine wetlands, and peaceful atmosphere.
- It's part of the Black Mountains National Park, making it a haven for wildlife lovers, photographers, and hikers.
- Great for short nature walks and birdwatching
- Continue to Gangtey
- Visit Gangtey Goempa – 17th-century monastery with panoramic valley views
- Explore Kumbhu Lhakhang – Unique temple dedicated to Bon deity Sipey Gyalpo
- Stop by Wangmo Carpet Factory – Women-led handwoven carpet center (great for souvenirs)
- Drive back to Punakha via Wangdue (Wangdiphodrang)
- Visit Wangdiphodrang Dzong, built in 1638, located at river confluence
- Evening: Return to Punakha
- Overnight stay in Punakha





DAY 6

TAKTSANG MONASTERY (TIGER'S NEST)

- After breakfast, drive to Paro and check into your hotel.
- Later, embark on a 4–5 hour trek to the iconic Taktsang Monastery (Tiger's Nest). Perched dramatically on a cliffside, this sacred site offers stunning panoramic views and a deeply serene atmosphere—truly a highlight of any visit to Bhutan.
- If time allows, explore additional cultural landmarks in Paro such as the Paro Fortress, Paro Dzong, and Rimpung Dzong, each renowned for their rich history and traditional Bhutanese architecture.
- Return to your hotel in Paro for an overnight stay

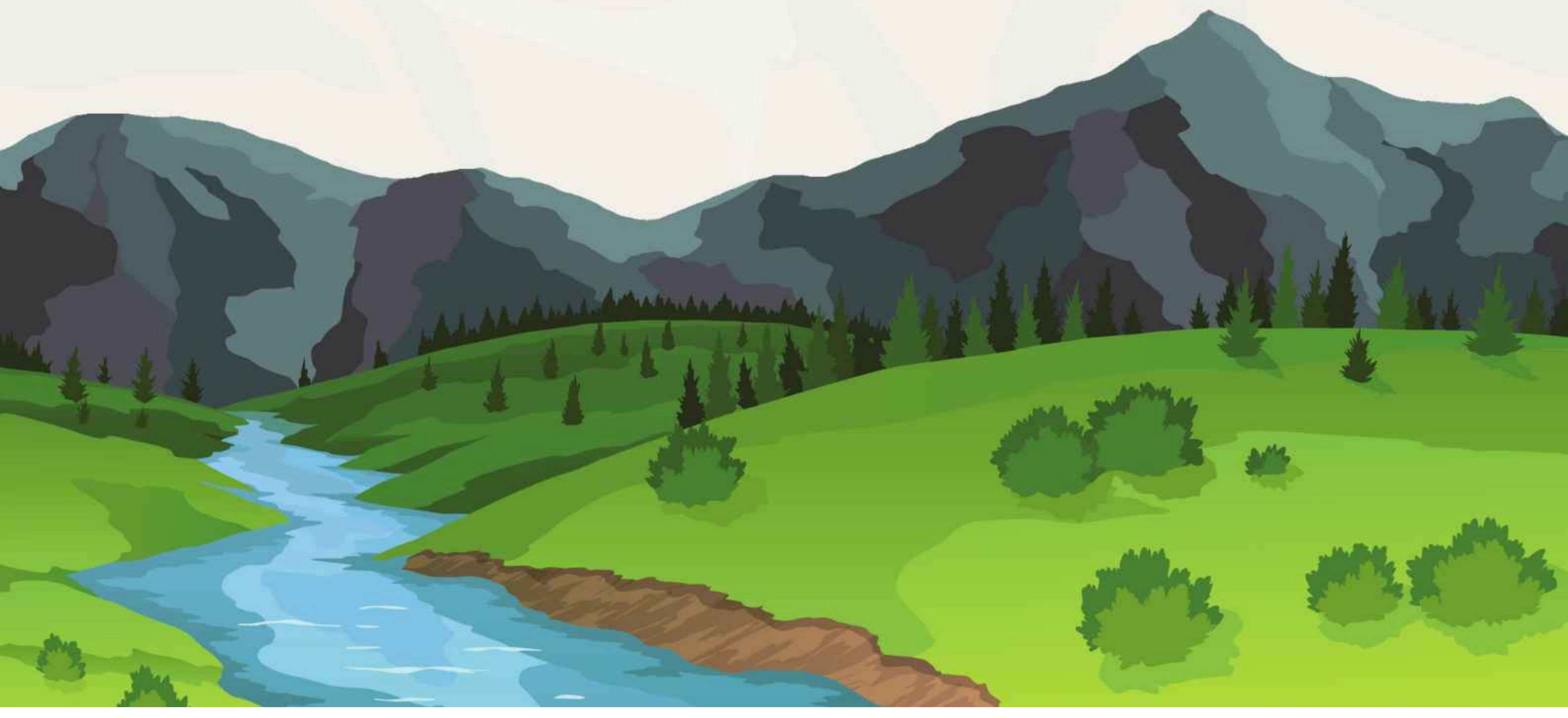




DAY 7

PARO TO SILIGURI – PARO AIRPORT VIEW POINT – ROAD JOURNEY (290 KM)

- Enjoy a delicious breakfast to start your day.
- Visit the Paro Airport Viewpoint, known for its challenging location and breathtaking scenery.
- Paro International Airport, Bhutan's only international airport, is located 6 km from Paro in a deep valley along the Paro Chhu River. The airport is famous for its difficult approach, with only about 50 certified pilots worldwide able to land due to the surrounding 18,000-foot mountains..
- Enjoy the stunning landscapes as you travel and cross Phuentsholing into India.
- Arrivel in Siliguri by evening and check in to your hotel.
- Relax and unwind for the night.
- Overnight stay in Siliguri.





DAY 8

DEPARTURE

- After breakfast, check out from your hotel and self transfer to Bagdogra Airport or NJP Railway Station for your onward journey.(You can book the flight whenever the time suits you)

NOTE: Siliguri is the collection point, and a common drop will be arranged between 9:00–10:00 PM. Flights should be booked after 2:00 AM. For later flights, guests may wait at the airport or choose to be dropped at a nearby market.

DO'S

RESPECT LOCAL CUSTOMS & MONASTERIES

- Always walk clockwise around stupas & prayer wheels.
- Remove shoes & hats before entering monasteries and dzongs.
- Maintain silence inside religious sites.

FOLLOW BHUTAN'S DRESS CODE IN DZONGS & MONASTERIES

- Wear full-sleeved shirts, long pants, and closed shoes.
- Avoid shorts, sleeveless tops, and hats inside religious places.

CARRY BHUTANESE NGULTRUM (BTN) OR INDIAN RS (₹)

- Indian ₹500 and ₹2000 notes are not accepted; carry ₹100 denominations.

PACK FOR CHANGING WEATHER

- Layered clothing is best since temperatures vary across locations.
- Comfortable trekking shoes for Tiger's Nest hike.

TRY LOCAL BHUTANESE CUISINE

- Must-try: Ema Datshi (spicy cheese & chili dish), Suja (butter tea), Red Rice.

KEEP YOUR ENTRY PERMIT & PASSPORT HANDY

- You will need your permit for check-posts when traveling between cities.



DONT'S

NO PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (PDA)

- Holding hands is okay, but kissing or hugging in public is considered disrespectful.

DO NOT POINT AT RELIGIOUS OBJECTS OR PEOPLE

- Use an open palm instead of pointing fingers.

AVOID DISRESPECTING THE ROYAL FAMILY

- Criticizing Bhutan's King or Government is strictly discouraged.

DON'T SMOKE IN PUBLIC PLACES

- Bhutan has strict anti-smoking laws. Carry import permits if bringing cigarettes.

DO NOT LITTER

- Bhutan takes cleanliness seriously. Use designated bins.

AVOID BUYING ANTIQUE RELIGIOUS ARTIFACTS

- Taking antique religious items out of Bhutan is illegal.

NO OUTSIDE DRONES ALLOWED

- Flying drones requires special permits from the Bhutanese government.



NOTES

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR BHUTAN:

- Bring your original Voter Card or a valid Indian passport. (Passport with six months of validity from the last day of your Bhutan trip)
- For Children (Under 18): - Passport or Birth Certificate.
- Notice: Aadhaar Card is not accepted for adults or children.
- If using a Voter ID, it must be the original issued by a government
- Please carry your 04 (four) copies of Passport size photo and ID proof (Voter ID card / Passport) for permission to visit Bhutan. In this connection please note that Aadhaar Card for identity purpose is not accepted in Bhutan.

Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount
