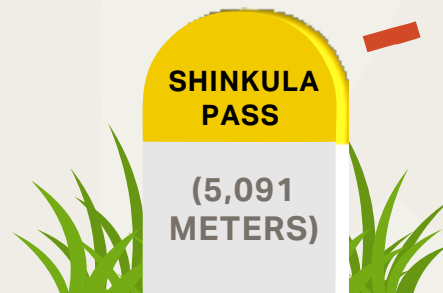

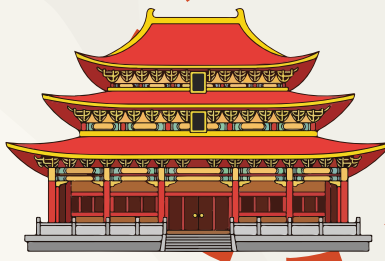

DAY 0

DELHI TO MANALI | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY

- Assemble at the pickup point by 8 PM (tentative) in Delhi, Kashmere Gate (tentative).
- Meet trip captains and attend a brief orientation session.
- Board an overnight Volvo bus to Manali, excited for the journey ahead.
- Dinner en route at a roadside restaurant (decided by the Volvo vendor).
- Ilu → Manali
- Approx distance: 540 km | 12–14 hrs

Note: This is an overnight journey; keep essentials in your carry bag.





DAY 1

MANALI ARRIVAL & LOCAL SIGHTSEEING | OVERNIGHT STAY IN MANALI

- Arrive in Manali and check into your hotel.
- Freshen up and enjoy a hearty breakfast at the hotel.
- Attend a welcome briefing to learn about the itinerary, altitude guidelines, and upcoming travel plans.
- Spend the rest of the day at leisure for light exploration or relaxation.
- You may visit nearby attractions such as Hadimba Temple, Vashisht Temple Hot Springs, Jogini Waterfall, or Mall Road on your own.
- Return and stay overnight in Manali.

Note: Avoid heavy physical activity, alcohol, and smoking for proper acclimatisation.





DAY 2

MANALI → JISPA | OVERNIGHT STAY IN JISPA

- Have an early breakfast and check out from your hotel in Manali before beginning the journey towards Jispa (3,200 m).
- Drive via the Atal Tunnel (3,060 m), passing through Sissu (3,120 m) and Keylong while enjoying the scenic Himalayan landscapes.
- En route, witness beautiful views of the Bhaga River and continue the drive across the majestic Baralacha La (4,890 m).
- The journey offers stunning mountain vistas and riverside views throughout the route.
- Arrive in Jispa by evening, where acclimatisation is advised due to the high altitude.
- Enjoy dinner at your stay, followed by an overnight stay in Jispa.





DAY 3

JISPA → PADUM | OVERNIGHT STAY IN PADUM

- Start your day with an early departure towards Padum.
- Cross the high-altitude Shinku La (5,091 m), taking in the breathtaking mountain views.
- Continue with a scenic drive through the remote and rugged Zaskar Valley.
- Arrive in Padum by evening and check in to your accommodation.
- Take some time to rest and relax after the journey.
- Overnight stay will be in Padum.

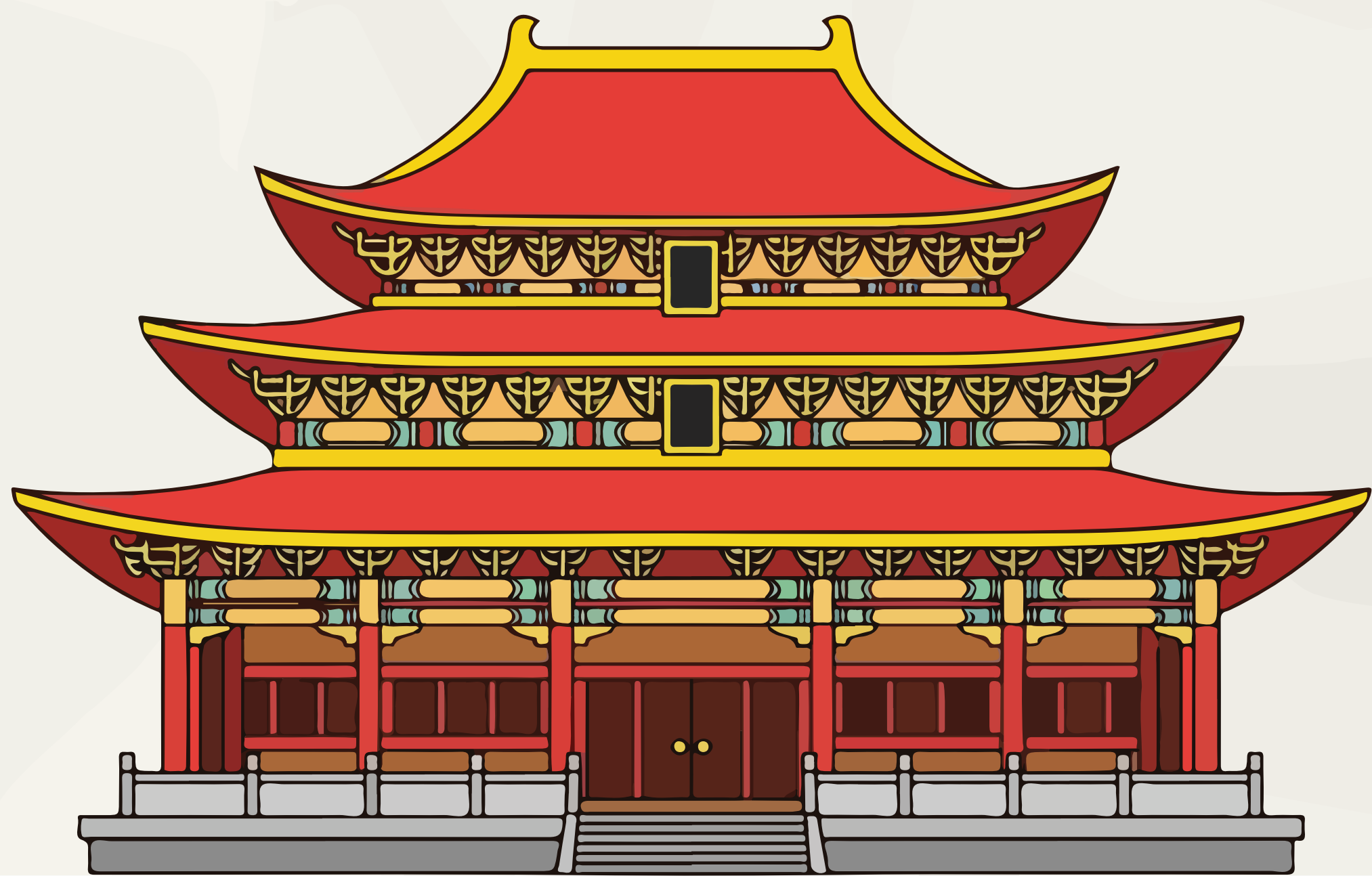

DAY 4

PADUM LOCAL SIGHTSEEING | OVERNIGHT STAY IN PADUM

- Day 4 of your trip starts with a hearty breakfast, before setting out for a full day of sightseeing around Padum.
- Visit Karsha Monastery, Stongdey Monastery, and the historic Zangla Fort, also visit the Zaskar River viewpoints along with visits to nearby villages and riverside landscapes.
- Lunch will be served en route, with the evening free to relax or explore at your own pace.
- Enjoy a stargazing experience, depending on the weather.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Padum.





DAY 5

PADUM → GOMBO RANGJON (CAMPS) VIA PHUKTAL MONASTERY | OVERNIGHT STAY IN GOMBO RANGJON

- Start your day with an early departure to make the most of the journey ahead.
- Visit Phuktal Monastery, which requires a short trek and offers breathtaking views of the monastery built into the cliffside.
- After the visit, continue your drive towards Gombo Rangjon, enjoying the dramatic landscapes along the way.
- Upon arrival, settle into your camps near the sacred mountain and take in the serene surroundings.
- In the evening, enjoy a stargazing experience under the clear night sky (weather permitting).
- Conclude the day with an overnight stay in camps amidst the peaceful wilderness.





DAY 6

GOMBO RANGJON → MANALI | OVERNIGHT STAY IN MANALI

- Start your day with an early breakfast at the camp before preparing for departure.
- Begin your return drive via Shinku La (5,091 meters), enjoying the stunning high-altitude views along the way.
- Continue the journey until you reach Manali by evening.
- Check in to your hotel and relax after the long drive, followed by an overnight stay in Manali..

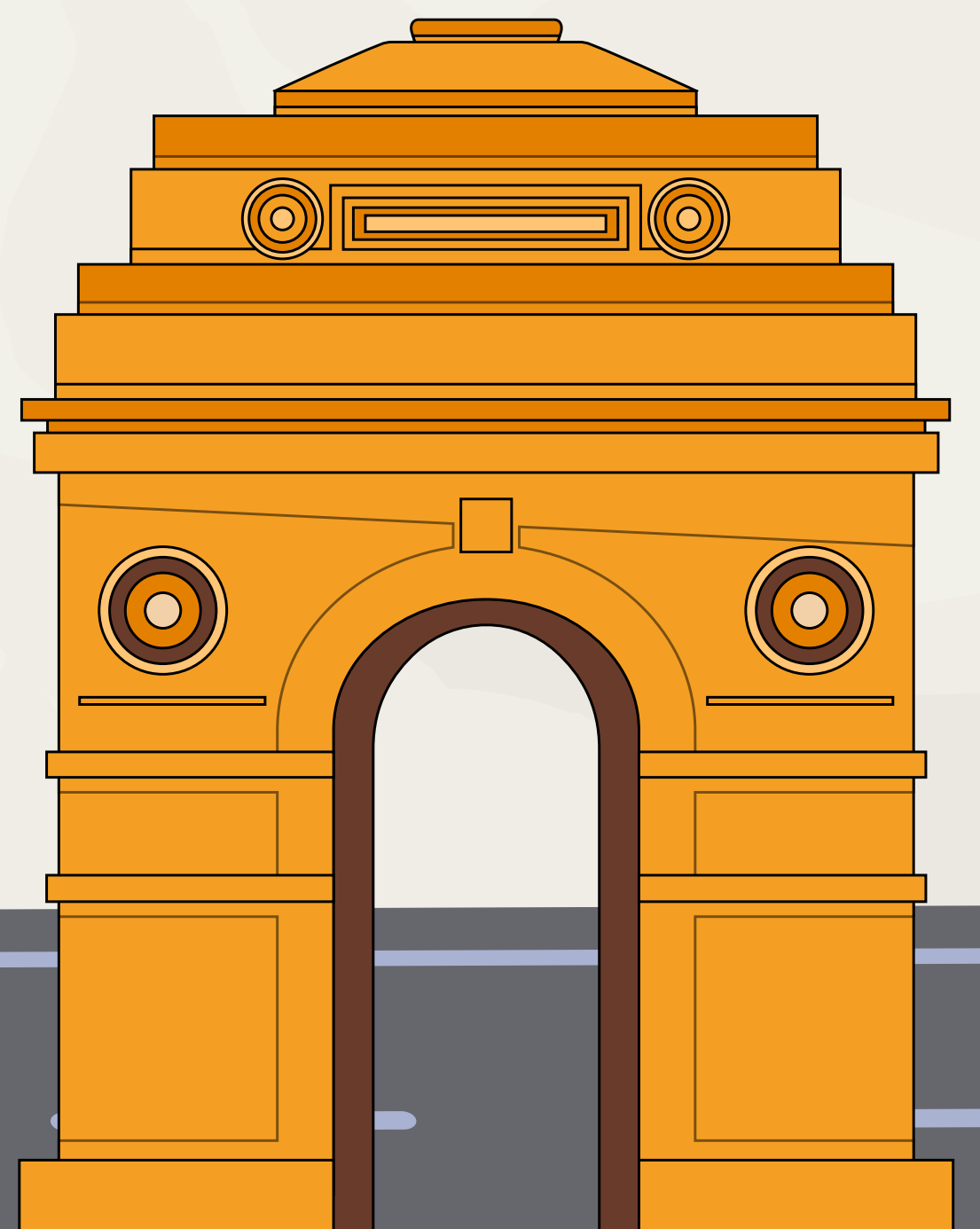
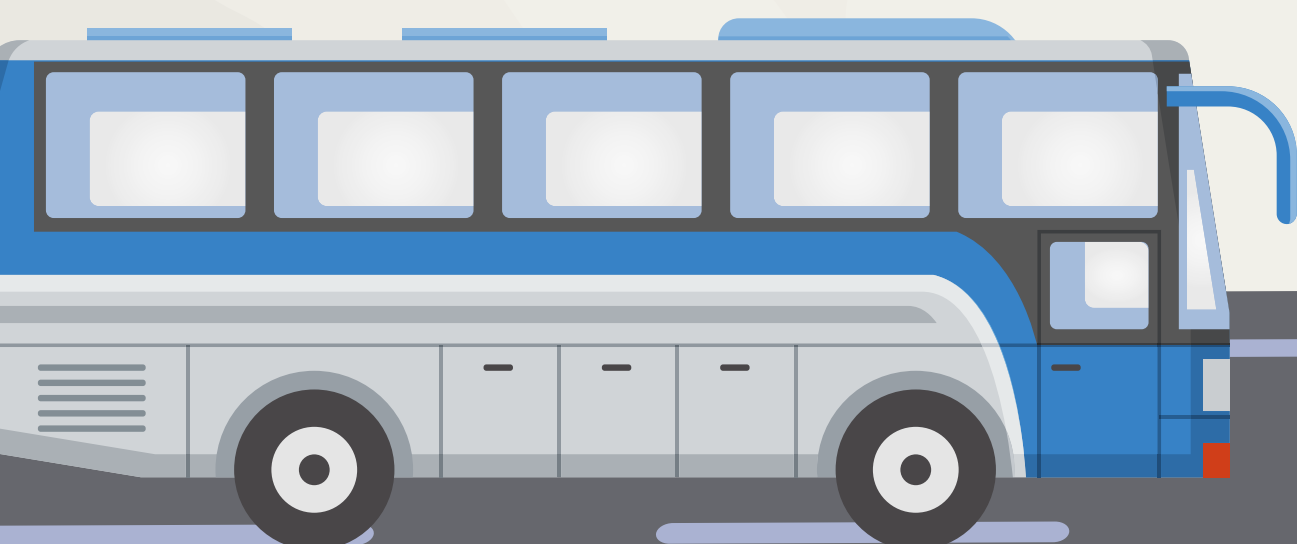

DAY 7

MANALI → DELHI | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY

- Start your day with an early breakfast before checking out of your stay in Manali.
- Explore Old Manali Cafe's, and local sightseeings on your own.
- In the evening, arrive at the Manali Volvo stand for your overnight Volvo bus journey to Delhi.

- Accommodation type may vary depending on location and availability.
- Meals are fixed as per mountain-friendly menus.
- Weather and road conditions may affect daily schedules.
- All meals are provided as per the MAP plan; preferences may need personal adjustments.
- Some activities, like bonfires, depend on weather conditions.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms & Conditions outline the agreement between ('You' or 'The Customer') and Capture A Trip ('We', 'The Company' or 'Us'). By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.
- Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or goods of travelers during the tour.



TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

- Customers are responsible for meeting all the health requirements, including necessary vaccinations. Any underlying medical conditions must be disclosed to Capture A Trip beforehand.
- Customers must follow all safety instructions during the trip. Failure to do so may result in removal from the tour without a refund.
- Participation in adventure activities is at the traveler's own risk. Customers must ensure they are medically fit. Capture A Trip is not liable for any injury, accident, or loss of life resulting from such activities.



TRIP EXECUTION:

- Capture A Trip reserves the right to modify the itinerary due to weather, road closures, political unrest, natural calamities, or safety issues.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delays or alterations in the program or indirectly incurred expenses in cases such as natural hazards, accidents, weather conditions, landslides, political closure or any untoward incident.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delay in reaching the destination due to traffic, sightseeing/activities of the day may get cancelled if we don't reach the destination on time.
- The trip organizer/coordinator has the complete right to change the itinerary as per the real-time conditions.

TRIP BOOKINGS:

- Registrations/Tickets once booked cannot be exchanged, cancelled, or refunded.
- In the event that the company is unable to operate a specific tour for any reason, alternative arrangements may be offered at the company's discretion. Once such alternatives have been provided, no further claims or objections shall be entertained.
- If the company makes alterations to your booked tour or holiday after your reservation has been confirmed, the following options will be made available to you:
 - You can go along with the altered tour or holiday plans.
 - Alternatively, you can opt for a different tour or holiday that the company suggests.
- In either of these cases, you won't be able to claim any compensation for damages, extra expenses, or any other losses.
