

DAY 1

COCHIN TO MUNNAR (130KM/4HRS)

- Arrival at Cochin Airport/Railway Station, greeted and picked up for your journey to Munnar (approx. 140km/4.5hrs).
- Enroute, witness the breathtaking Cheeyappara Waterfalls, Valara Waterfalls (seasonal), Karadippara Viewpoint, and the lush Tea Gardens.
- Optional Zip Line experience for adventure lovers.
- Upon arrival, check-in to your hotel and relax.
- Overnight stay in Munnar.





DAY 2

MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING

- Start the day with a hearty breakfast.
- Explore Munnar with a full-day sightseeing tour, visiting iconic places like Mattupetty Dam, Kundala Lake, and Echo Point.
- In the afternoon, visit Eravikulam National Park (Rajamala – closed during Feb/Mar).
- Evening highlights include a visit to the Tea Factory/Tea Gardens, Rose Garden, Blossom Park, and Tea Museum(closed on Mondays).
- Overnight stay in Munnar.






DAY 3

MUNNAR TO THEKKADY (110KM/3.5HRS)

- After breakfast, check out and proceed to Thekkady (approx. 110km/3.5hrs).
- Upon arrival, check into your hotel.
- Visit the famous Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary (optional boat ride available). Explore the nearby Spice Plantations and indulge in optional activities like an Elephant Safari, Kathakali & Kalaripayattu cultural shows, Ayurvedic massages, and Jeep Safari.
- Overnight stay in Thekkady.





DAY 4

THEKKADY TO ALLEPPEY/KUMARAKOM (155KM/4HRS)

- Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before checking out and heading to Alleppey/Kumarakom.
- Upon arrival, check-in at your hotel/resort.
- Discover the charm of Alleppey/Kumarakom, a region renowned for its tranquil backwaters, verdant paddy fields, lush mangrove forests, and coconut groves.
- Optional Shikara Ride or leisure time at the resort.
- Overnight stay in Alleppey/Kumarakom.





DAY 5

ALLEPPEY/KUMARAKOM TO KOVALAM (165KM/4.5HRS)

- After breakfast, check out and proceed to Kovalam.
- On the way, stop by the fascinating Jatayu Earth Centre (Jatayu Park), a unique heritage site.
- Upon reaching Kovalam, check in to your hotel and spend a relaxing evening on the famous Kovalam Beaches.
- Overnight stay in Kovalam.





DAY 6

TRIVANDRUM DAY TOUR

- After breakfast, embark on a day trip to Trivandrum, the capital city of Kerala.
- Visit the iconic Padmanabhaswamy Temple, Sree Chitra Art Gallery, Napier Museum, Trivandrum Zoo, Shangumugham Beach, and indulge in shopping at Lulu Mall.
- Return to Kovalam in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Kovalam.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
