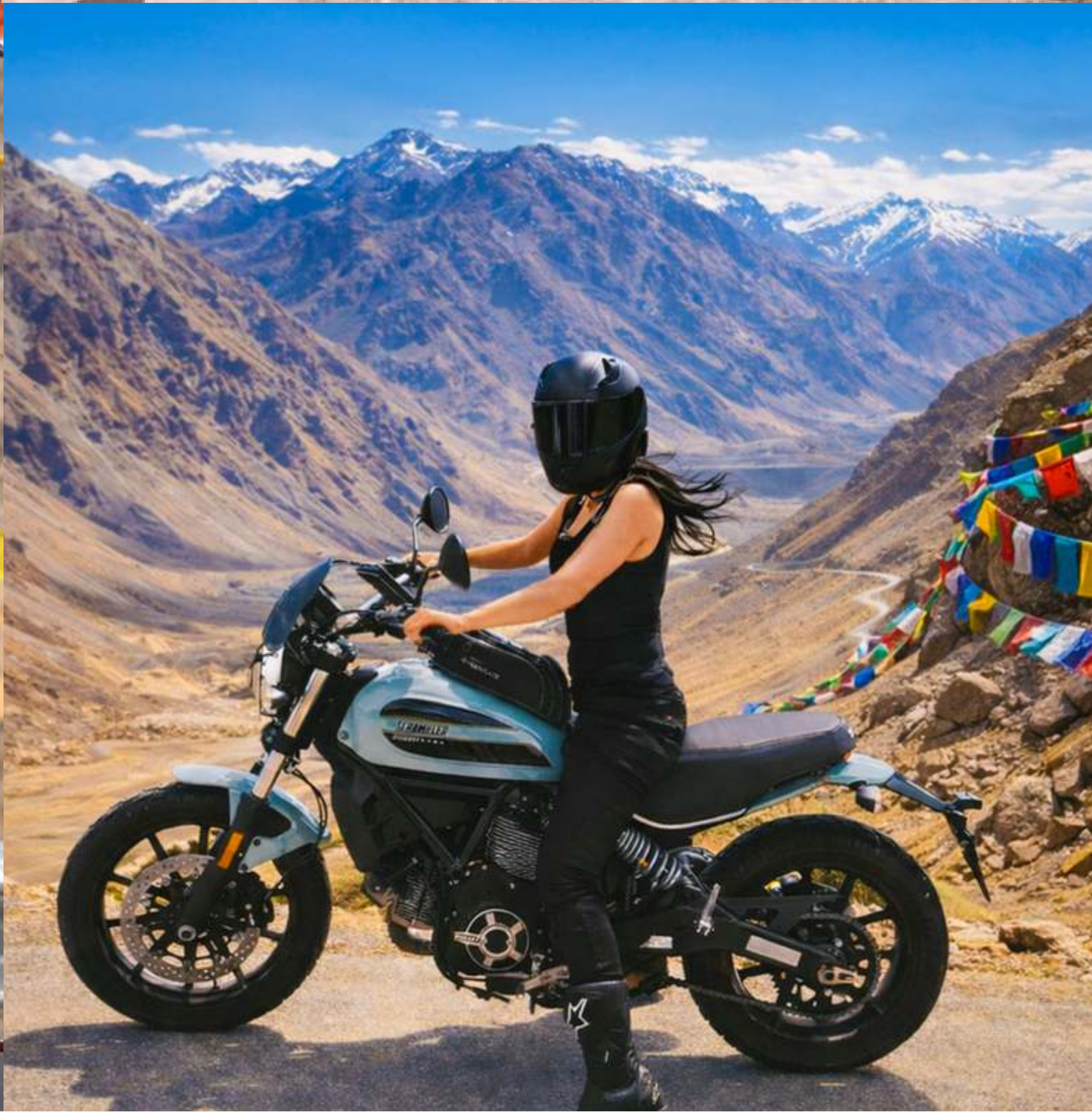

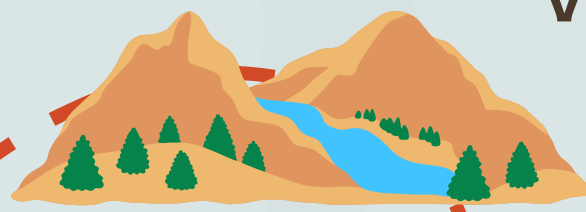

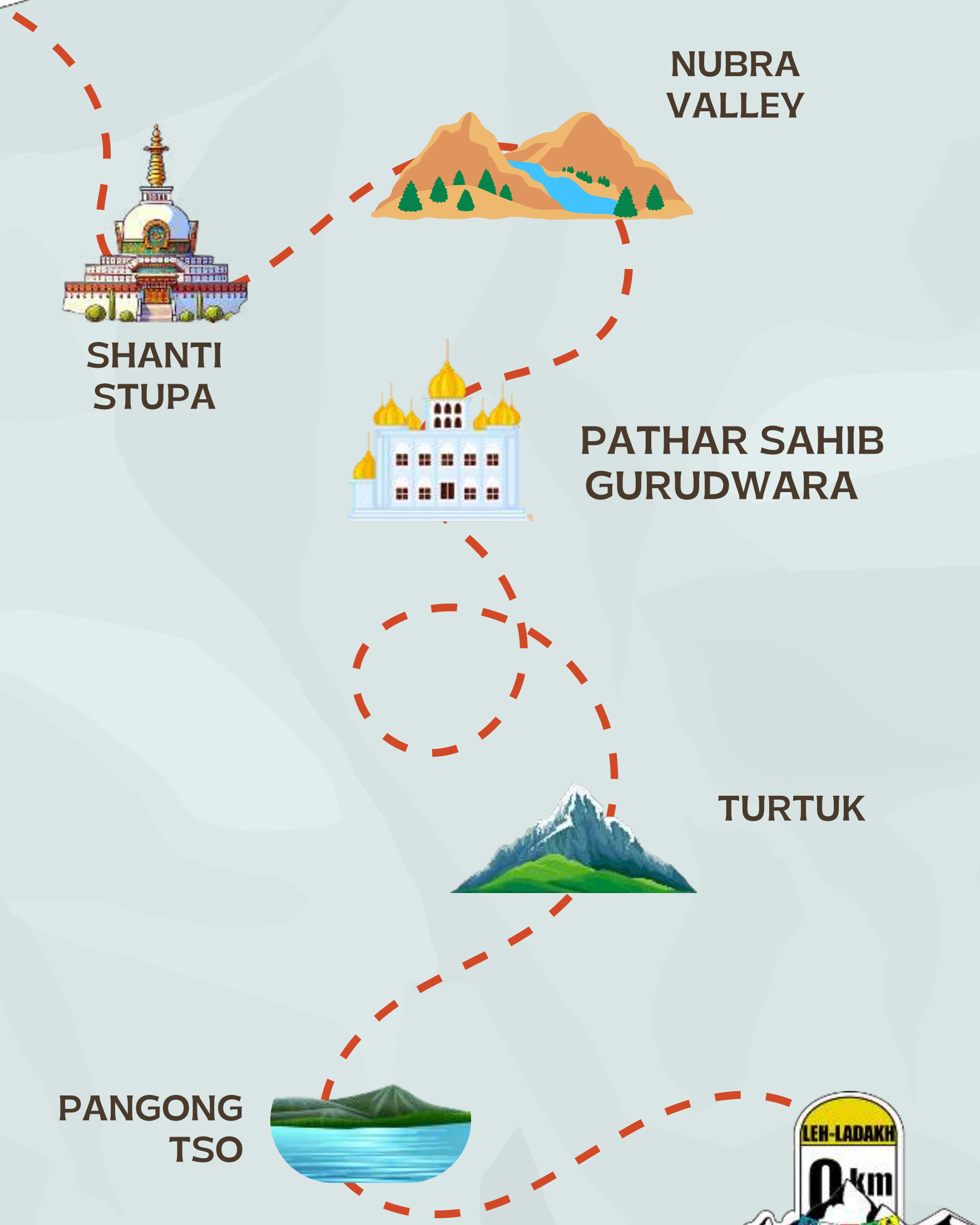

LEH LOCAL SIGHTSEEING | OVERNIGHT STAY IN LEH

- Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the **Hall of Fame Museum, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Magnetic Hill, and the confluence point of the Indus and Zaskar River**
- Explore **Shanti Stupa** and enjoy panoramic views and sunset photography.
- Take an optional stroll through **Leh Market** for shopping and cafés.
- Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 3

LEH → KHARDUNG LA → NUBRA VALLEY | OVERNIGHT IN NUBRA

- Depart from Leh after enjoying a wholesome breakfast
- Ride towards Nubra Valley while crossing **Khardung La (18,080 ft)**, one of the highest motorable roads in the world.
- Later, explore the **Diskit Monastery**, the largest and oldest monastery in Ladakh, famous for the **100-foot Maitreya Buddha**.
- Arrive in **Nubra Valley** and explore the cold desert landscape and **Hunder Sand Dunes**.
- Optional activities such as **double-hump camel rides** or **ATV rides** can be enjoyed at personal expense.
- Check in to the campsite, enjoy a bonfire (weather permitting), have dinner, and stay overnight in **Nubra Valley**.

HIGHLIGHTS: KHARDUNG LA (18,080 FT), NUBRA VALLEY LANDSCAPES, DISKIT VILLAGE, HUNDER SAND DUNES, OPTIONAL CAMEL SAFARI & ATV ACTIVITIES

- Walk through the village, visit the **Balti Museum & the Shyok River**
- Experience local culture and scenic views
- Return to Nubra by evening and enjoy the bonfire
- Dinner and overnight stay

DAY 5

NUBRA VALLEY → PANGONG LAKE (VIA SHYOK) | OVERNIGHT AT PANGONG

- Reach the spectacular **Pangong Lake**, known for its surreal blue shades that shift with the sunlight.
- Visit the famous Bollywood shooting spots from **3 Idiots** and **Jab Tak Hai Jaan**.
- Check in to your lakeside cottage by evening.
- Enjoy dinner and unwind by the tranquil waters of Pangong.

- Reach Leh by evening.
- Explore markets, enjoy the cafés, and pick up souvenirs.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

- Carry ₹5,000 in cash (ATMs available only in Manali/Leh)
- Bikers: Carry ₹10,000, as ₹5,000 is required as a security deposit per bike

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.
- Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or goods of travelers during the tour.



TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.
