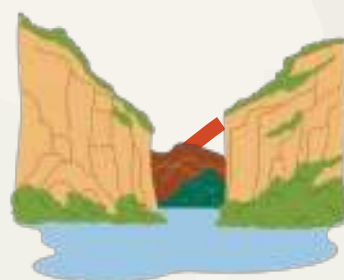

DAY 1

GUWAHATI ARRIVAL | UMIAM LAKE | OVERNIGHT AT SHILLONG

- Arrival at Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport in the morning. Arrive by 11:00 AM and proceed for Shillong after breakfast.
- After lunch, visit Umiam Lake and then head to Shillong market for shopping.
- Check in at the hotel and freshen up.
- Overnight stay in Shillong.





DAY 2

SHILLONG TO CHERAPUNJI | LYNGKSIAR WATERFALL | ARWAH CAVE | NOHKALIKAI FALL

- Wake up and enjoy breakfast with a scenic view.
- Check out from the hotel and visit the beautiful Lyngksiar Waterfall.
- Later, depart for Arwah Cave and immerse yourself in its breathtaking beauty.
- After lunch, continue towards Cherrapunji .
- Upon arrival in Cherrapunji , visit Nohkalikai Falls, one of the most spectacular waterfalls in the region.
- Check in at the resort and unwind in the evening.
- Enjoy dinner and overnight stay at Cherrapunji .





DAY 3

TREK TO SINGLE ROOT BRIDGE | DOUBLE DECKER BRIDGE

- After breakfast, depart for Tyrna Village.
- On the route of tyrna village we will visit seven sister waterfall (if time permits).
- Upon reaching Tyrna, begin your trek to the Single Root Bridge.
- Later, visit the astonishing Double Decker Bridge. Trek back to Tyrna Village, completing a total of 3300 steps one way and 6600 steps for the entire trek.
- After the trek, continue your journey to Cherrapunji .
- Arrive at Cherrapunji and check in for your overnight stay.
- Refresh and unwind in Cherrapunji .

DAY 4

MAWSMAI MAWLYNNONG VILLAGE | OVERNIGHT AT SHNONGPDENG (DAWKI DOM CAMPS)

- Post breakfast, Visit Mawsmmai Caves
- Mawsmmai to Mawlynnong village .
- Later transfer to Shnongpdeng Village.
- Arrive at Shnongpdeng & check in to the camps. Camping near by the crystal clear umngot river which is also known as Dawki river
- Dinner will be provided at the camp site.
- Overnight stay at Shnongpdeng.

NOTE: STAY IN SHNONGPEDENG WILL BE IN ALPINE/DOME TENTS WITH COMMON WASHROOM. THESE CAMPS ARE SITUATED IN AN AREA SURROUNDED BY STONES, SO PLEASE BE PREPARED FOR A BASIC SETUP. YOU'LL FIND ONLY MATTRESSES OR SLEEPING BAGS PROVIDED FOR YOUR STAY. IT'S WORTH NOTING THAT THESE CAMPS ARE LOCATED NEAR THE RIVER, WHICH CAN MAKE THE APPROACH A BIT CHALLENGING AT TIMES



DAY 5

WATER SPORTS | KRANG SURI WATERFALL | OVERNIGHT STAY AT SHILLONG

- Enjoy breakfast with a view of the crystal-clear Umngot River at Shnongpdeng.
- Engage in various water sports activities on the Umngot River.
- Have lunch at a local restaurant in Shnongpdeng.
- Depart for Shillong, stopping en route to visit the scenic Krang Suri Waterfall.
- Upon arrival in Shillong, explore the local market known for its vibrant atmosphere and diverse offerings.
- Overnight stay in Shillong.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:
