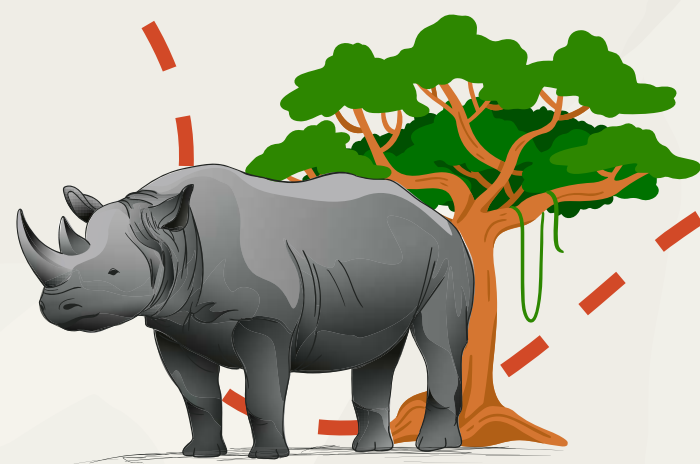




BRIEF MAP

DAY 1

GUWAHATI ARRIVAL | TRANSFER TO KAZIRANGA | OVERNIGHT STAY IN KAZIRANGA

- Overnight accommodation in Kaziranga.





DAY 2

JUNGLE SAFARI IN KAZIRANGA | OVERNIGHT IN SHILLONG

- Wake up early and enjoy the beautiful jungle safari.
- Have breakfast and then depart for Shillong.
- Reach Shillong by evening.





DAY 3

LAITLUM GRAND CANYON | KRANG SHURI WATERFALLS | OVERNIGHT AT SHNONGPDENG

- Wake up and enjoy your breakfast.
- Check out and depart for Laitlum Canyons.
- Spend time mesmerized by the amazing beauty.
- Head towards Shnongpdeng.
- En route, visit the stunning Krang Shuri Falls.
- Arrive at Shnongpdeng and marvel at the crystal-clear Umngot River.
- Check in to the camps and relax in the evening.
- Enjoy a bonfire, dinner, and sleep overnight.

NOTE: STAY IN SHNONGPEDENG WILL BE IN ALPINE/DOME TENTS WITH COMMON WASHROOM. THESE CAMPS ARE SITUATED IN AN AREA SURROUNDED BY STONES, SO PLEASE BE PREPARED FOR A BASIC SETUP. YOU'LL FIND ONLY MATTRESSES OR SLEEPING BAGS PROVIDED FOR YOUR STAY. IT'S WORTH NOTING THAT THESE CAMPS ARE LOCATED NEAR THE RIVER, WHICH CAN MAKE THE APPROACH A BIT CHALLENGING AT TIMES

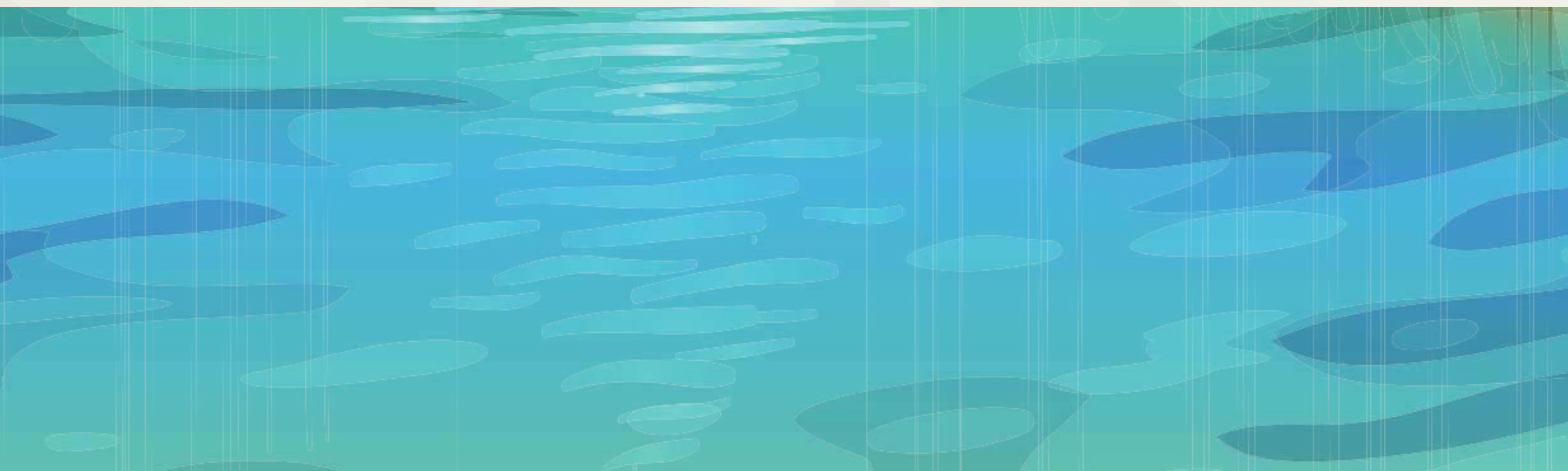




DAY 4

WATER ACTIVITIES | MAWLYNNONG | CHERRAPUNJI

- Enjoy your breakfast with a view of the crystal-clear river water.
- Participate in various water activities during the morning.
- After lunch, proceed towards Mawlynnong, known as Asia's cleanest village.
- Arrive in Cherrapunji by evening and check in to your hotel.
- Overnight stay in Cherrapunji.





DAY 5

SINGLE ROOT BRIDGE | DOUBLE DECKER BRIDGE | OVERNIGHT STAY IN CHERRAPUNJII

- After breakfast, depart for Tyrna Village.
- On the route of tyrna village we will visit seven sister waterfall (if time permits).
- Upon reaching Tyrna, begin your trek to the Single Root Bridge.
- Next, visit the impressive Double Decker Bridge. Trek back to Tyrna Village (this trek involves 3300 steps one way, totaling 6600 steps for the entire trek).
- Afterward, continue your journey to Cherrapunjee.
- Overnight stay in Cherrapunjee.

NOTES

- Travellers residing outside Guwahati are recommended to book trains/flights reaching Guwahati not delay than 12 PM on the trip start date. Similarly, on the trip end date, book the returning flight/ train departure post 6 PM respectively.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. may cause itinerary change. We reserve the right to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general wellbeing.
- The age limit of our group departures is 18 to 40 years due to the power-packed itineraries that we provide for our travellers. We can customise trips for travellers beyond the mentioned age bracket.
- Currently, there is a village dispute near Wei Sawdong in Cherrapunjee. As a result, the government has prohibited tourist visits to the waterfalls there. Instead, we will visit Lyngkshiar Waterfalls. We are in constant communication with our ground team, and as soon as Wei Sawdong becomes accessible for tourists, we will resume visits to that location.
- Stay in Shnongpedeng will be in Alpine/Dome Tents with common washroom.
- Additionally, since this is not a leisure trip and several of our sightseeing locations are in rural areas, we kindly request that you avoid late-night strolling around the hotel for your safety and convenience.



CAT CARE

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.
