DAY 1

ARRIVAL AT TBILISI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT | TRANSFER TO HOTEL | FREE TIME TO REST 28 DECEMBER

- Arrival at Tbilisi International Airport, where you will be greeted by a designated driver for a group hotel transfer.
- Only one common transfer will be arranged, based on the majority of travelers' arrival times.
- Check-in at a hotel in Tbilisi, the capital and largest city of Georgia, situated along the Mtkvari River.
- Founded in the 5th century by a Georgian monarch, Tbilisi has served as the capital of various Georgian kingdoms and republics.

- Breakfast at the hotel, followed by transfer to Gudauri
- Visit Zhinvali Reservoir, constructed in the 1980s, offering stunning views of the lake and surrounding forested hills
- Explore Ananuri Fortress, a well-preserved 13th-century castle complex with picturesque lake views
- Stop at the Friendship Monument, a Soviet-era viewpoint offering breathtaking views of the Caucasus Mountains
- Drive to Kazbegi and visit the Gergeti Trinity Church, a 14th-century monastery perched beneath Mount Kazbek – one of Georgia's most iconic landmarks

- Holy Trinity Church (Sameba Cathedral) – A magnificent symbol of Georgia's spiritual revival and one of the largest Orthodox churches in the world
- Cable Car to Mother of Georgia – Take a scenic ride to the iconic statue symbolizing hospitality and strength
- Shardeni Street – A lively street filled with charming cafés, art galleries, and vibrant nightlife
- Narikala Fortress – A medieval fortress offering breathtaking city views, perfect for history lovers
- Sulfur Baths & Waterfall – Famous for their naturally warm, healing waters and a hidden waterfall nearby
- Mtatsminda Park – An amusement park atop Mtatsminda Mountain, featuring thrilling rides, a Ferris wheel, and stunning views of Tbilisi

KAKHETI WINE REGION: SIGHNAGHI & BODBE MONASTERY 31 DECEMBER

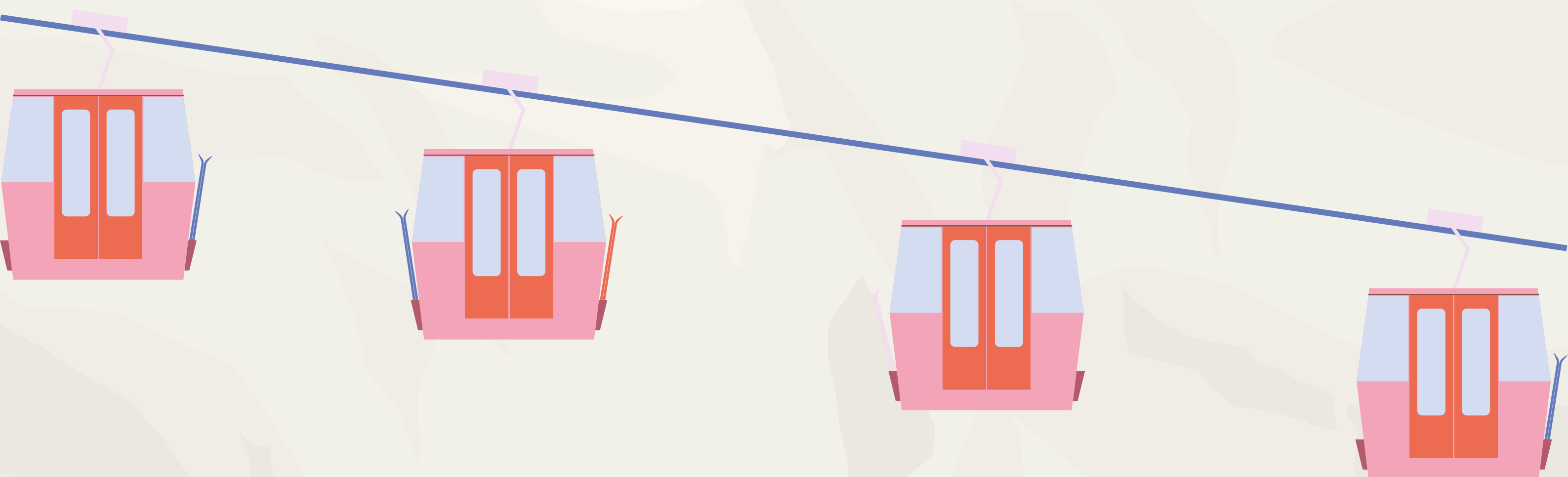

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
