- The city offers a rich mix of culture, history, shopping, and nightlife.
- Take time to experience Manila's lively streets, iconic sights, and warm, energetic locals.

MANILA FLIGHT TO BORACAY VIA CATICLAN | AIRPORT TRANSFERS & HOTEL CHECK-IN

- According to your flight schedule, you will be picked up and transferred to Manila Airport for your domestic flight to Caticlan.
- Arrive at Caticlan Airport (Godofredo P. Ramos Airport), the main gateway to the paradise island of Boracay.
- Proceed to the Jetty Port for a 15-minute boat crossing to Boracay Island.
- Upon arrival in Boracay, enjoy a comfortable transfer from the port to your hotel for check-in.
- Spend the rest of the day at leisure.
- Boracay Island, located in Western Visayas, is one of the Philippines' most iconic tourist destinations.
- The island is 7 km long and shaped like a dumbbell, featuring a world-famous 4 km stretch of powdery white sand beach.
- Known for having some of the finest beaches in the world, Boracay offers crystal-clear waters, vibrant marine life, and a variety of water sports.





BORACAY ISLAND HOPPING | ILIG-ILIGAN BEACH, PUKA BEACH, CROCODILE ISLAND, CRYSTAL ISLAND, MAGIC ISLAND

- After breakfast, your guide will meet you at the hotel for your island-hopping experience.
- Enjoy a hassle-free tour including boat transfers, entrance fees, snorkeling fees, and sunset sailing fees.
- First stop: Ilig-Iligan Beach, a quiet, lesser-known spot in northern Boracay ideal for snorkeling and scenic ocean views.
- Continue to Puka Beach, known for its soft white sand mixed with crushed puka shells.
- Relax on the beach or opt for additional water sports such as parasailing, sea walking, or diving (optional, payable onsite).
- Visit Crocodile Island, famous for its crystal-clear waters and its crocodile-shaped formation.
- Enjoy a delicious lunch at Kawa Beach.
- After lunch, proceed to Crystal Cove Island, a private island featuring two beautiful natural caves with crystalclear water illuminated by sunlight.

BORACAY ISLAND HOPPING | ILIG-ILIGAN BEACH, PUKA BEACH, CROCODILE ISLAND, CRYSTAL ISLAND, MAGIC ISLAND

- Note: The sand is coarse; walking barefoot is not recommended.
- Head to Magic Island for cliff diving, with jumping platforms ranging from 3 to 10 meters. Guests who prefer not to dive can simply enjoy watching the thrill from the sidelines.
- End the day with sunset sailing at Friday Beach, a traditional and romantic experience during golden hour.
- Activities may be adjusted based on weather conditions.
 Safety is the top priority, and certain activities may be rescheduled or cancelled in case of strong winds or unfavorable conditions.





BORACAY TO EL NIDO BY FLIGHT

- After breakfast, it's time to island-hop!
- Check out from Kuta and cruise your way to the Gili Islands car-free, carefree, and drop-dead gorgeous.
- Arrive and check in to your beachside stay.
- Spend the rest of the day at leisure chase sunsets, sip fresh coconut, or explore the island by foot or cycle.





EL NIDO ISLAND HOPPING 1 | TOUR A: MINILOC ISLAND, SHIMIZU ISLAND, SEVEN COMMANDO BEACH

- After Breakfast, enjoy your first El Nido island hopping experience with the popular El Nido Tour A in Bacuit Bay.
- Begin with a boat ride to Miniloc Island to explore its breathtaking lagoons, including the Big Lagoon and the Secret Lagoon.
- Visit the Secret Lagoon, accessed through a small opening in the rocks, revealing a hidden natural pool once inside.
- Enjoy at Payong-Payong Beach on Miniloc Island, known for its scenic white sand and clear waters.
- Continue to Shimizu Island, one of the best snorkeling spots in El Nido with vibrant corals and diverse marine life.
 It is also known for its striking limestone formations.
- A delicious grilled lunch is typically served here or on a nearby beach, featuring grilled meat, seafood, vegetables, rice, and fresh fruits.

EL NIDO TO PUERTO PRINCESA | CROCODILE FARM, MITRA'S RANCH, IMMACULATE CONCEPTION CATHEDRAL, PLAZA CUARTEL

- Relax on the beach, swim, or enjoy a refreshing drink while admiring the ocean views. Keep an eye out for sea turtles while snorkeling.
- After completing El Nido Tour A, return to El Nido Town for your overnight stay.
- After breakfast, travel to Puerto Princesa City, the capital of Palawan. The drive is about 270 km and takes around 5 to 6 hours.
- Upon arrival, meet your guide and begin your half-day Puerto Princesa city tour.
- Visit the Crocodile Farm, formerly known as the Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center. This breeding center is home to two endemic crocodile species, the Philippine crocodile and the Saltwater crocodile.
- See baby crocodiles up close and explore other rescued wildlife such as the Palawan bearcat, eagles, bearded pigs, and myna birds.
- For food lovers, try the famous exotic dish Crocodile Sisig, available inside the center.
- If time permits, proceed to Mitra's Ranch for a panoramic view of Puerto Princesa City and the Sulu Sea. Optional activities such as ziplining and paintball are available.



DAY 6: CONTINUED

EL NIDO TO PUERTO PRINCESA | CROCODILE FARM, MITRA'S RANCH, IMMACULATE CONCEPTION CATHEDRAL, PLAZA CUARTEL

- Visit the nearby Baker's Hill, a fun theme park known for its delicious baked treats.
- Continue to the Immaculate Conception Cathedral, a historic Roman Catholic church first built where the city's earliest mass was held in 1872. It is a peaceful and beautiful place to reflect.
- Walk across to Plaza Cuartel, a historic site that was once a Spanish garrison and later the location of the tragic Palawan Massacre during World War II.
- Overnight stay in Puerto Princesa, known as the city of the Living God.





UNDERGROUND RIVER EXPERIENCE – PUERTO PRINCESA

- After breakfast get ready for the Underground River Experience.
- Explore the awe-inspiring Puerto Princesa Underground River, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New 7 Wonders of Nature.
- Glide through a majestic cave system on a paddle boat and witness stunning stalactites, stalagmites, and unique rock formations.
- Experience the world's longest navigable underground river in a serene natural setting.
- Optional activities: Enjoy an exhilarating zip line over the lush forest or a peaceful mangrove paddle boat tour showcasing Palawan's rich coastal biodiversity.
- A perfect blend of nature, wonder, and adventure.





PUERTO PRINCESA BACK TO MANILA & MANILA HALF DAY CITY TOUR

- After Breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Manila, which takes about 1.5 hours.

- Visit key attractions within Intramuros including:
- San Agustin Church, the oldest church in the Philippines and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

- Casa Manila, a recreated 1850s colonial mansion showcasing Spanish-era lifestyle and antique Filipino furnishings.
- Manila Cathedral, the first cathedral in the Philippines dedicated to the Immaculate Conception.
- Manila American Cemetery and Memorial (if time permits), home to 17,206 World War II graves and one of the most beautifully maintained cemeteries in the world.
- End your tour at Fort Santiago, a historic Spanish fortress and one of Manila's most significant heritage sites. It is where Dr. Jose Rizal was imprisoned and wrote his final poem My Last Farewell before his execution in 1896.
- Overnight stay in Manila.

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.
