- Overnight stay in Colombo.

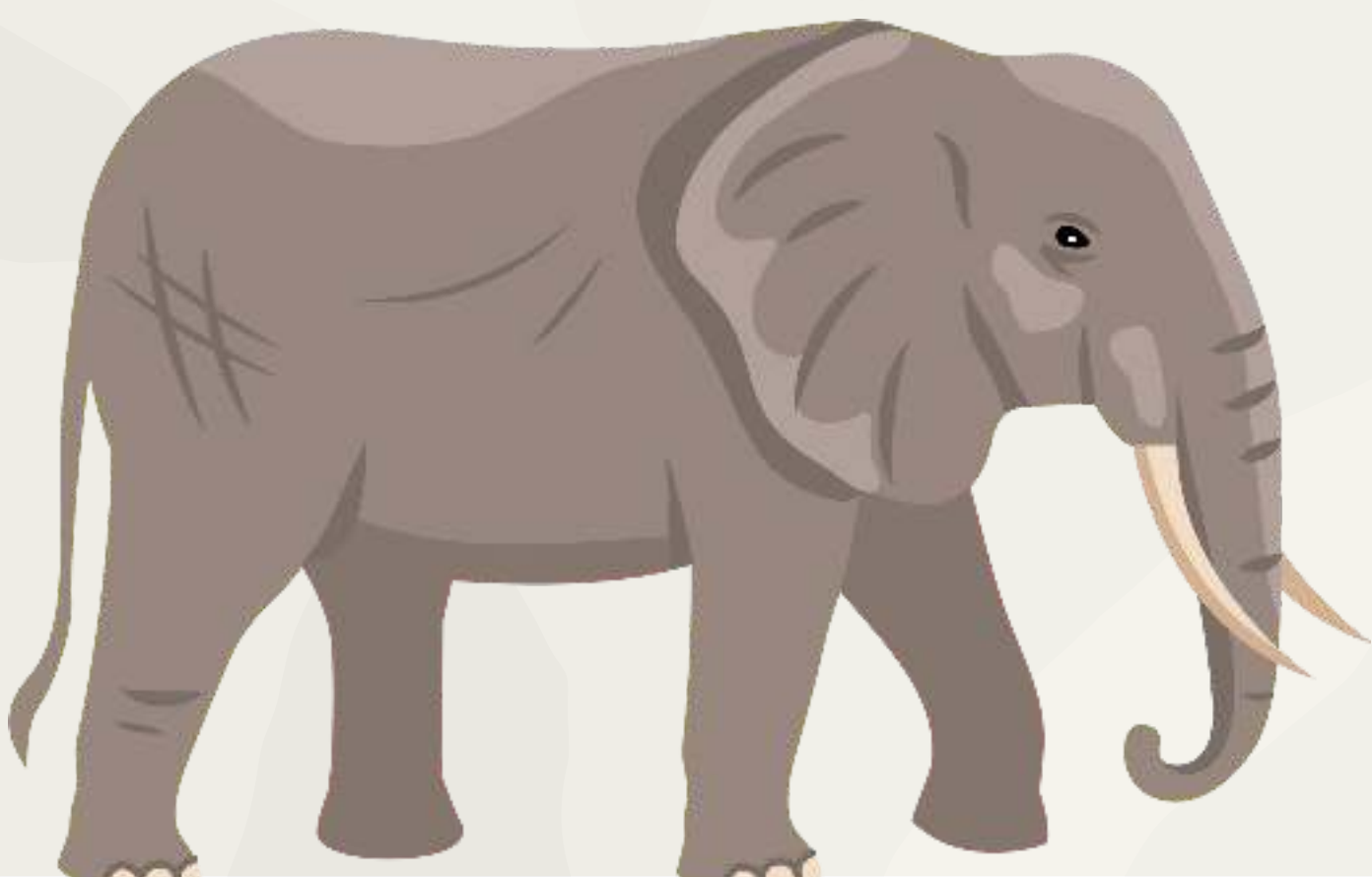




## DAY 2

- After breakfast, depart for Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage (Approx. 2.5 hrs)
- Watch elephants bathe and feed.
- Continue to Kandy (Approx. 1.5 hrs)
- Visit Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic.
- Explore Kandy Lake and Bazaar.
- Optional: Kandyan Cultural Dance Show.
- Overnight stay and Dinner in Kandy.





## **DAY 3**

### **KANDY – SIGIRIYA – PIDURANGALA – DAMBULLA – KANDY**

- Early morning transfer to Sigiriya (Approx. 2.5 hrs)
- Climb Pidurangala Rock.
- On return: Visit Dambulla Cave Temple (UNESCO site)
- Return to Kandy for Dinner and overnight stay.







# DAY 4

## KANDY – RAMBODA – NUWARA ELIYA – ELLA

- Stop at Ramboda Waterfall.
- Visit Tea Factory & Plantation near Nuwara Eliya.
- Short city tour in Nuwara Eliya ("Little England")
- Continue the journey to Ella by train (Approx. 5 hrs total from Kandy)
- One gala dinner in Ella.
- Halt at Nine Arches Bridge.
- Overnight stay in Ella.

- Hike to Little Adam's Peak.
- Optional: Ravana Falls, Ella Rock, or Flying Ravana Zipline.

- Overnight stay in Ella.

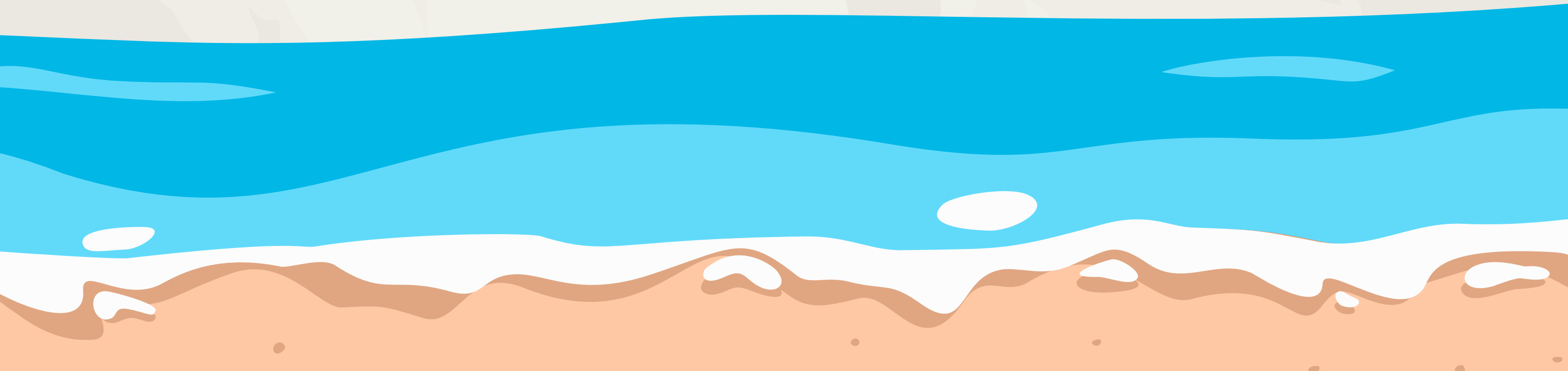




# DAY 6

## DO'S IN SRI LANKA

- Respect local customs and traditions. Dress modestly, especially when visiting temples or religious sites.
- Remove your shoes and hats before entering temples and homes.
- Use your right hand for giving and receiving things, as the left hand is considered unclean.
- Try the local cuisine and street food — it's delicious and a big part of the experience!
- Carry a reusable water bottle and stay hydrated, but only drink bottled or purified water.
- Bargain politely in markets and shops, but always keep a friendly attitude.
- Use sunscreen and insect repellent to protect yourself from the sun and mosquitoes.
- Respect wildlife and nature — avoid feeding animals and stick to marked trails.
- Learn a few basic Sinhala or Tamil phrases; locals appreciate the effort.
- Use registered taxis or tuk-tuks and agree on the fare beforehand.
- Carry some cash as small vendors may not accept cards.





# DON'TS IN SRI LANKA

- Don't wear revealing clothing especially when visiting religious or rural areas.
- Don't touch someone's head — it's considered disrespectful.
- Don't point your feet at people or religious objects; feet are seen as unclean.
- Don't take photos inside temples or of locals without permission.
- Don't litter or damage the environment. Keep Sri Lanka clean.
- Don't engage in public displays of affection, as this may offend local sensibilities.
- Don't drink tap water; always use bottled or filtered water.
- Don't discuss politics or the civil war openly with strangers.
- Don't buy or possess illegal drugs — penalties are severe.
- Don't rush or show impatience; Sri Lanka has a laid-back vibe, so go with the flow.

# CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms & Conditions outline the agreement between ('You' or 'The Customer') and Capture A Trip ('We', 'The Company' or 'Us'). By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

## **PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:**

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

## **BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:**

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



### **SAFETY & CONDUCT:**

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

### **ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:**

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.
- Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or goods of travelers during the tour.



### **TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:**

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY:**

- Customers are responsible for meeting all the health requirements, including necessary vaccinations. Any underlying medical conditions must be disclosed to Capture A Trip beforehand.
- Customers must follow all safety instructions during the trip. Failure to do so may result in removal from the tour without a refund.

- Registrations/Tickets once booked cannot be exchanged, cancelled, or refunded.
- In the event that the company is unable to operate a specific tour for any reason, alternative arrangements may be offered at the company's discretion. Once such alternatives have been provided, no further claims or objections shall be entertained.
- If the company makes alterations to your booked tour or holiday after your reservation has been confirmed, the following options will be made available to you:

  - Alternatively, you can opt for a different tour or holiday that the company suggests.
- In either of these cases, you won't be able to claim any compensation for damages, extra expenses, or any other losses.
