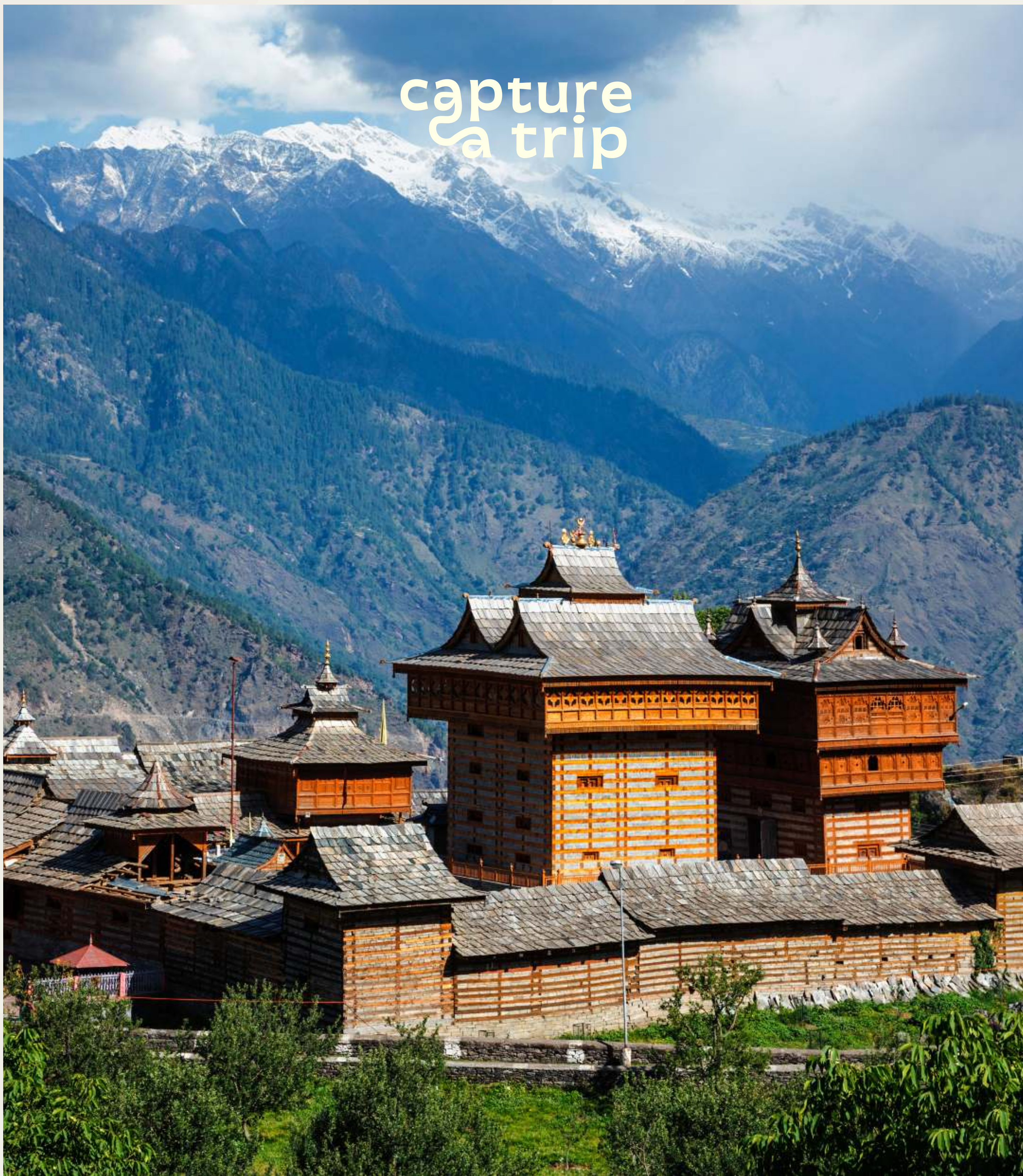

DAY 1

ARRIVAL IN GUWAHATI | DRIVE TO NAMERI (220 KM)

- Welcome to Guwahati! Once everyone has arrived at the pickup point, you'll meet your trip captain and fellow travelers.
- We'll then start our journey to Nameri National Park, located at the base of the Eastern Himalayas. It's a peaceful place full of nature and home to animals like elephants, tigers, and hornbills.
- After reaching, we'll check into our stay surrounded by greenery.
- Evening is free to relax.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Nameri.
- Note: Check-in time is 1:00 PM.





DAY 2

RIVER RAFTING | DRIVE TO DIRANG (160 KM)

- We'll start the day with an exciting river rafting session in the Jia-Bhoreli River. (River rafting is subject to weather condition)
- After breakfast and the activity, we'll leave for Dirang, a beautiful hill town with great mountain views and a cool climate.
- After reaching, check into the hotel and rest.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Dirang.





DAY 3

DRIVE TO TAWANG VIA SELA PASS (125 KM)

- After breakfast, we drive to Tawang, a lovely town at 10,000 ft altitude. On the way, we'll stop at the Sela Pass and Sela Lake – both surrounded by snow.
- We'll also visit Jaswant Garh War Memorial.
- After reaching Tawang, check into your hotel.
- Evening is free to relax or visit local cafes.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Tawang.





DAY 4

BUM LA PASS EXCURSION – BACK TO TAWANG

- Today, we'll leave early to visit the famous Bum La Pass near the Indo-China border, located at 15,200 ft. The views are snowy and breathtaking.
- We'll also visit P.T. Tso Lake and Madhuri Lake (also called Shonga-tser Lake), which was featured in a Bollywood movie.
- Return to Tawang by evening.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Tawang.

NOTE- For bumla pass tempo traveller is not allowed we will arrange another vehicle for excursion





DAY 5

TAWANG LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- After breakfast, we'll explore some beautiful places in Tawang:
- Tawang Monastery – the largest in India
- Urgelling Monastery – one of the oldest, and birthplace of the 6th Dalai Lama
- Giant Buddha Statue – 30 ft tall overlooking Tawang
- Chakzam Bridge – a 600-year-old hanging bridge
- Tawang War Memorial – honoring Indian soldiers
- In the evening, we'll watch a light and sound show at the memorial.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Tawang.





DAY 6

DRIVE TO BOMDILA (166 KM)

- After breakfast, we head to Bomdila, a peaceful town with amazing mountain views.
- On the way, we'll stop at Jung Falls, a waterfall made famous in the movie Koyla.
- Reach Bomdila and check into your hotel.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Bomdila.





DAY 7

DRIVE TO KAZIRANGA (180 KM)

- After breakfast, we travel to Kaziranga National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in Assam.
- It's home to the famous One-Horned Rhino, along with elephants, wild buffaloes, and many birds.
- Check in and relax amidst nature.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Kaziranga.

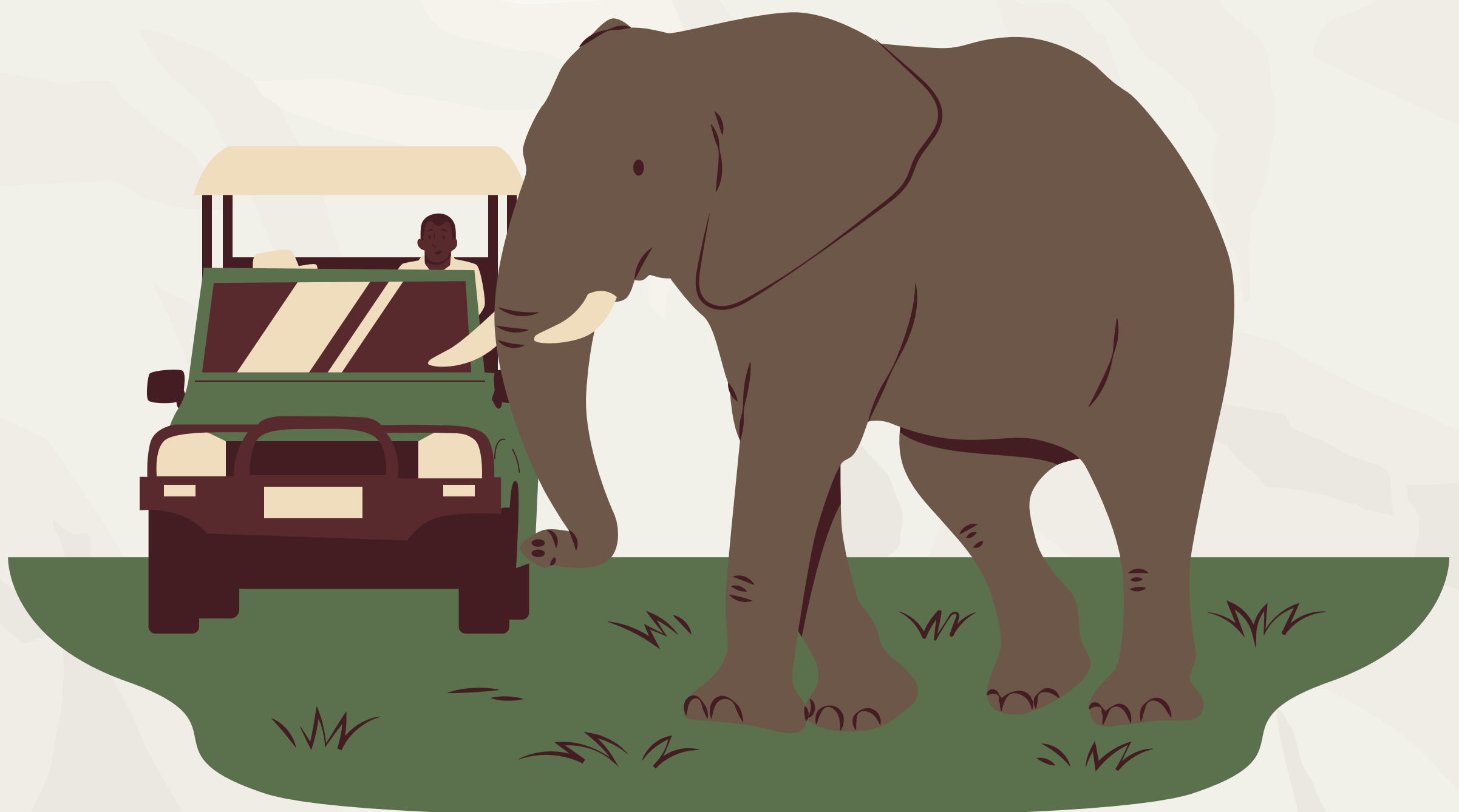




DAY 8

- Travelers residing outside Guwahati are recommended to book trains/flights reaching Guwahati not delay than 12 PM on the trip start date. Similarly, on the trip end date, book the returning flight/ train departure post 6 PM respectively.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. may cause itinerary change. We reserve the right to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general well-being.
- The age limit of our group departures is 18 to 40 years due to the power-packed itineraries that we provide for our travellers. We can customise trips for travellers beyond the mentioned age bracket.
- Additionally, since this is not a leisure trip and several of our sightseeing locations are in rural areas, we kindly request that you avoid late-night strolling around the hotel for your safety and convenience.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms & Conditions outline the agreement between ('You' or 'The Customer') and Capture A Trip ('We', 'The Company' or 'Us'). By booking any trip or service through Capture A Trip, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agreed to be legally bound by these terms and conditions. Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and its organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.
- Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or goods of travelers during the tour.



TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

- Customers are responsible for meeting all the health requirements, including necessary vaccinations. Any underlying medical conditions must be disclosed to Capture A Trip beforehand.
- Customers must follow all safety instructions during the trip. Failure to do so may result in removal from the tour without a refund.
- Participation in adventure activities is at the traveler's own risk. Customers must ensure they are medically fit. Capture A Trip is not liable for any injury, accident, or loss of life resulting from such activities.



TRIP EXECUTION:

- Capture A Trip reserves the right to modify the itinerary due to weather, road closures, political unrest, natural calamities, or safety issues.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delays or alterations in the program or indirectly incurred expenses in cases such as natural hazards, accidents, weather conditions, landslides, political closure or any untoward incident.
- Capture A Trip is not responsible for any delay in reaching the destination due to traffic, sightseeing/activities of the day may get cancelled if we don't reach the destination on time.
- The trip organizer/coordinator has the complete right to change the itinerary as per the real-time conditions.

TRIP BOOKINGS:

- Registrations/Tickets once booked cannot be exchanged, cancelled, or refunded.
- In the event that the company is unable to operate a specific tour for any reason, alternative arrangements may be offered at the company's discretion. Once such alternatives have been provided, no further claims or objections shall be entertained.
- If the company makes alterations to your booked tour or holiday after your reservation has been confirmed, the following options will be made available to you:
 - You can go along with the altered tour or holiday plans.
 - Alternatively, you can opt for a different tour or holiday that the company suggests.
- In either of these cases, you won't be able to claim any compensation for damages, extra expenses, or any other losses.
