Escape to the breathtaking Spiti Valley this Christmas & New Year and experience the Himalayas in their most magical winter avatar.

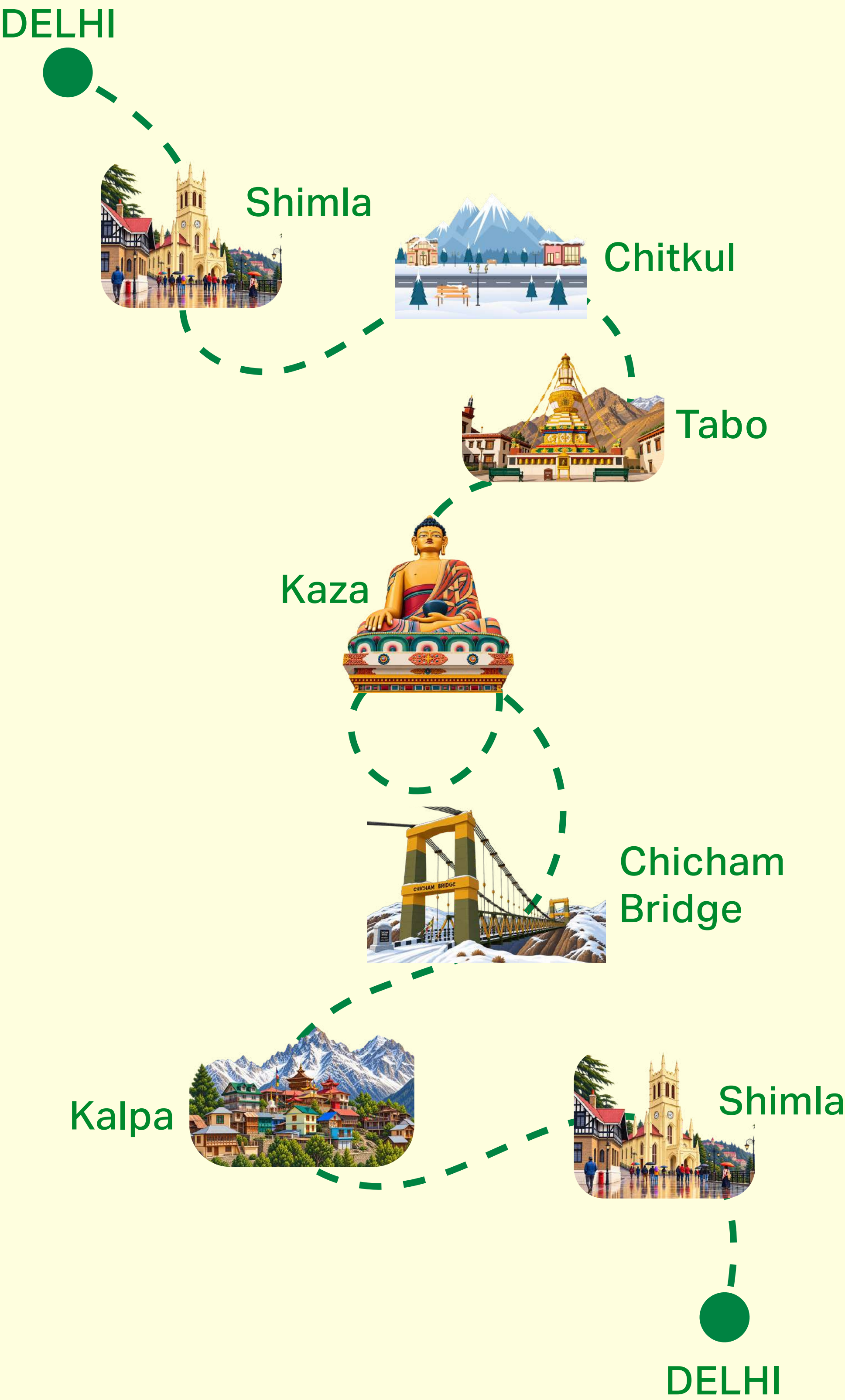

DEPARTURE FROM DELHI TO SHIMLA

- We depart from Delhi around 9:30 PM in an AC Vehicle.

MAJNU KA TILA (NEAR VIDHAN SABHA METRO STATION)**

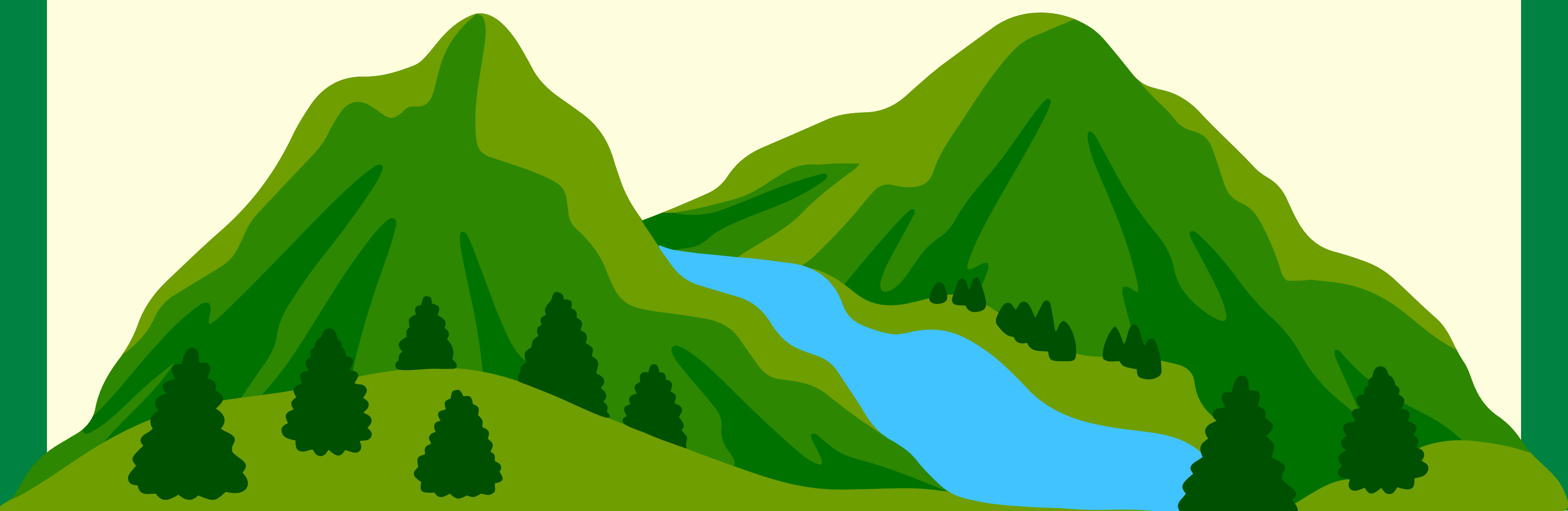


DAY-1



DRIVE FROM SHIMLA TO THE LAST INDIAN VILLAGE | DINNER & OVERNIGHT STAY IN CHITKUL/SANGLA

- Drive through [Kufri and Narkanda](#) along the Indo-Tibetan Highway on your way to Chitkul.
- Enter the [Kinnaur Valley](#) by crossing the Kinnaur Gate, a rock tunnel famously known as the [Gateway to Kinnaur](#). This tunnel is located around 170 km from Shimla on the Shimla-Kaza road, also called the Hindustan-Tibet Road.
- Explore the last Indian village before the China border and immerse yourself in the stunning white wonderland.
- Arrive in [Chitkul/Sangla](#) by evening.
- Dinner and an overnight stay in Chitkul/Sangla.

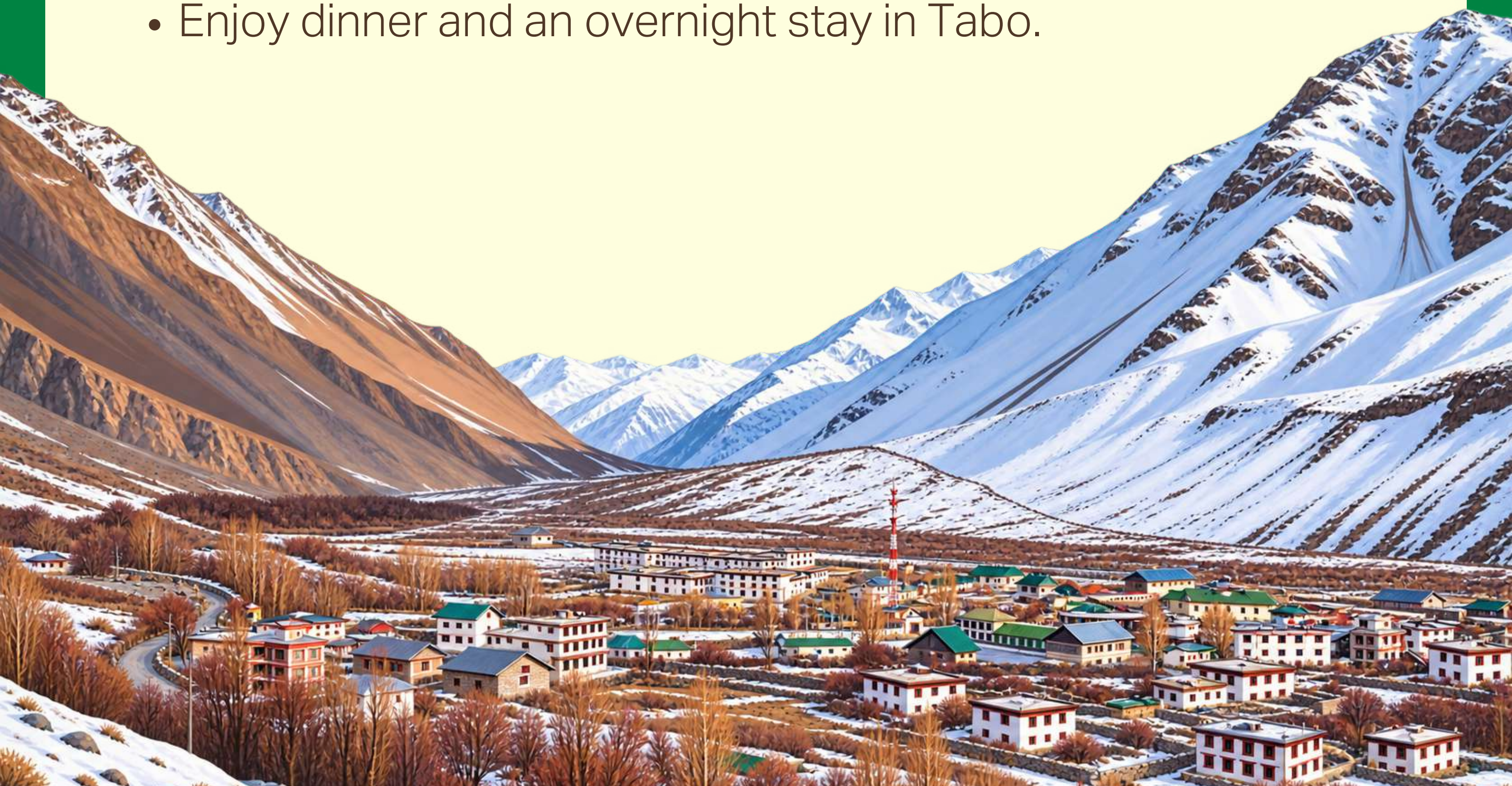


DAY-2



DRIVE FROM CHITKUL TO TABO VIA NAKO | VISIT LINGTI WATERFALL (WEATHER PERMITTING) | DINNER & OVERNIGHT STAY IN TABO

- Wake up early, enjoy breakfast, and begin your journey to Spiti Valley.
- Drive through the scenic [Ka Loops](#) while soaking in the breathtaking Himalayan landscapes.
- En route, visit the beautiful [Lingti Waterfall](#) (subject to weather and road conditions).
- Arrive in [Tabo](#) by evening and check in to your accommodation.
- Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay in Tabo.



DAY-3

➤ VISIT TABO MONASTERY & DHANKAR MONASTERY | DINNER & OVERNIGHT STAY IN KAZA

- Wake up early and enjoy breakfast.
- Begin your day with a visit to the ancient Tabo Monastery, the oldest monastery in Spiti Valley and a UNESCO World Heritage tentative site.
- Later, head towards [Dhankar Village](#) and visit the historic Dhankar Monastery, offering spectacular views of the confluence of the Spiti and Pin Rivers.
- Continue your journey to [Kaza](#).
- Reach Kaza by evening, check in to your hotel, enjoy dinner, and relax for the night.



DAY-4



VISIT HIKKIM, KOMIC & LANGZA | DINNER & OVERNIGHT STAY IN KAZA

- Post breakfast, head out to explore [Hikkim](#), home to the world's highest post office, where you can send postcards to your loved ones.
- Continue to Komic, one of the highest motorable villages in the world, and enjoy a meal at one of the highest cafés.
- Later, visit [Langza](#), famous for its giant Buddha Statue and ancient marine fossils.
- Return to Kaza for dinner and an overnight stay.



DAY-5



VISIT KEY MONASTERY & CHICHAM BRIDGE | DINNER & OVERNIGHT STAY IN KAZA

- Post breakfast, head out to visit the iconic **Key Monastery**, the largest monastery in Spiti Valley.
- Later, drive to the magnificent **Chicham Bridge**, Asia's highest suspension bridge, offering breathtaking views of the deep gorge below.
- Return to Kaza by evening.
- Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay in Kaza.



DAY-6



DEPARTURE TO KALPA VIA NAKO | VISIT NAKO LAKE | OVERNIGHT STAY IN KALPA

- Post breakfast, check out from the hotel and begin your journey towards [Kalpa](#).
- En route, stop at the picturesque [Nako Lake](#) and enjoy the serene surroundings of this beautiful Himalayan village.
- Continue your drive to Kalpa, enjoying the scenic mountain landscapes along the way.
- Reach Kalpa by night, check in to your hotel, have dinner, and enjoy an overnight stay.



DAY-7

► DEPART TO SHIMLA | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY TO DELHI

- Post breakfast, we check-out from the hotel and start our return journey to Delhi.
- We drive to Shimla first which is again a 10-11 hours journey and then an overnight journey by Volvo to Delhi.

NOTES

- Due to the high altitude, remote location, and extremely cold temperatures, common washroom facilities will be provided along with one bucket of hot water per person. Guests are kindly requested to be prepared accordingly. This arrangement is applicable only during extreme winter months.
- Access to high altitude regions of Spiti Valley, especially Hikkim, Komik, Langza Village and Pin Valley etc, may be congested during winter months due to extreme snowfall. Hence, the stopover to these locations is weather-dependent. In such a case, we will look for the best possible alternatives, as achievable.
- Kindly take note that in the event of any act of God, such as heavy snowfall leading to road closures for heavy vehicles, it will be the responsibility of the travelers to arrange for a 4x4 vehicle, and the associated expenses will be borne by the travelers themselves. Capture A Trip bears no responsibility for any such acts of God or the associated expenses.
- Travellers residing outside Delhi are recommended to book trains/flights reaching Delhi not delay than 4 PM on the trip start date. Similarly, on the trip end date, book the returning flight/ train departure post 2 PM respectively.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. may cause itinerary change. We reserve the right to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general wellbeing.
- The age limit of our group departures is 16 to 42 years due to the power-packed itineraries that we provide for our travellers. We can customise trips for travellers beyond the mentioned age bracket.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)
- If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.
- In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:
 1. 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
 2. 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
 3. 45 Days prior for International trips
- Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.
- In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:
 1. You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
 2. You can shift to a later date.
 3. You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or in case of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

- Customers are responsible for meeting all the health requirements, including necessary vaccinations. Any underlying medical conditions must be disclosed to Capture A Trip beforehand.
